HB2101 Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack Allows officers or employees of a municipality with a population of more than 2,500 to conduct business with said municipality; allows members of any board of education of a municipality with a population of over 2,500 to furnish materials or supplies to said municipality; allows members of any board of education within a municipality with a population of more than 2,500 to vote on contracts between area vocational-technical schools and the entity by which the member is employed.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/03/96, Prefiled

HB2102 Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack Provides for loss of business and economic incentives for railroads and public service corporations upon protest of ad valorem taxes; provides for proration of lost incentives.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/03/96, Prefiled

HB2103 Principal Author(s): O'Neal, Mike Deletes telecommunication installation and construction charges from the 4.5 percent excise tax on annual gross receipts or proceeds.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. 01/03/96, Prefiled

HB2104 Principal Author(s): Greenwood, Joan Authorizes the creation of a flag commemorating the April 19, 1995, bombing of the Murrah Federal Building.
