

**HB2167** Principal Author(s): Steidley, Dwayne Removes duty to lease hospital and equipment to charitable nonprofit organizations from the board of county commissioners.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2168** Principal Author(s): Steidley, Dwayne Increases juror's attendance fees paid from the court cash fund from \$12.50 to \$25.00.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2169** Principal Author(s): Steidley, Dwayne Enacts the Education Choice Act. Directs the State Board of Education to promulgate rules to facilitate transfer of pupils under certain circumstances. Requires the State Board of Education to consider all appeals for transfer which have been denied by local school district boards of education.; Effective Date: 07/01/97 Emergency. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2170** Principal Author(s): Hutchison, Joe J. Changes quail season hunting dates to the first Saturday in November to January 31.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2171** Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M. Modifies certain time periods and sets certain closure dates relating to solid waste disposal sites.; Emergency. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2172** Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M. Modifies Oklahoma Pawnshop Act. Prohibits issuing a license for a location within a county with a population of less than 11,000 or in counties of more than 11,000 population when there is an active pawnshop license for every 11,000 or fraction thereof of the population.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2173** Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M. States that retirement benefits received by persons over the age of sixty-five (65) shall be exempt from taxable income.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2174** Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M. Changes speed limits on all Oklahoma interstate highways and turnpikes to 70 m.p.h.; authorizes the Oklahoma Transportation Commission to set such limits.; Emergency. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2175** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E. Provides that the court may order restitution and clean up of trash in lieu of fine and jail sentence for the deliberate dumping of trash and/or littering public property.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2176** Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr. Creates the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act of 1996.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2177** Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L. Allows for written notification to the Department of Wildlife Conservation when a person wishes to hold animal pelts for longer than ten (10) days; states that any antlers or horns that are sold or traded shall be removed so as to not leave any portion of the skull attached; provides that such antlers or horns shall also be cut into pieces not longer than 12 inches.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. 01/05/96, Prefiled

**HB2178** Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M. Provides for credit of 180 days of unused annual leave for members of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System; states that the member's employer shall reimburse the system for the cost of funding the additional reserve; states provisions shall apply to only to members retiring or vesting on or after July 1, 1996 and shall not be retroactive.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2179** Principal Author(s): Thomas, Tommy Allows the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to accept federal grant money to augment programs within its jurisdiction to reimburse the state for any such assistance payments; allows the authority to make apportionments with said funds.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2180** Principal Author(s): Thomas, Tommy Modifies language relating to the Health and Dental Insurance Reserve Fund.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2181** Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M. Provides credit for 180 days of unused annual leave for members of the Oklahoma Public Employs Retirement System; states that the member's employer shall reimburse the system for the cost of funding the additional reserve; states that the provisions shall apply to members retiring or vesting on or after July 1, 1996 and shall not be retroactive.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2182** Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike States legislative intent to protect the rights of child witnesses; defines terms; states considerations that must be considered before deciding to accept the testimony of a child witness; establishes who can be present during the testimony of a child witness; provides for accompaniment of a child witness during testimony.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2183** Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike Requires the Department of Corrections to implement a plan by December 1, 1996 to require inmates participating in public works projects to wear leg irons in chain gang work groups.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2184** Principal Author(s): O'Neal, Mike Adds Garfield County to the list of counties in where musk, Scotch and Canada thistles are considered to be a noxious weed.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2185** Principal Author(s): O'Neal, Mike States that after conviction, municipal, prosecution and court records and court proceedings for cases involving children under the age of eighteen (18) charged with violating municipal ordinances shall be open to public inspection; states that juvenile court confidentiality restrictions shall not apply to a conviction in a municipal court of a child over the age of fourteen (14); Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2186** Principal Author(s): O'Neal, Mike Adds abortion clinic to the definition of 'related institution'; defines abortion clinic; clarifies language relating to rules and standards relating to the State Board of Health.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2187** Principal Author(s): Greenwood, Joan Directs the State Regents of Higher Education to promulgate and adopt rules providing guidelines for institutions, constituent agencies and higher education centers for the determination of the eligibility of a student to be a person who has obtained adequate health care insurance sufficient to qualify for the Student Health Care Fee of \$46.00.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2188** Principal Author(s): Greenwood, Joan Modifies the definition of 'medical savings account' to include that which is offered by the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board; allows any funds remaining in a medical savings account at the end of a tax year to be remain in the account for future medical expenses; provides for payment of account funds to the account holder in the event the employee is no longer employed; also provides for an option to retain the account after employment; also allows for transfer of account to a new employer without penalty; requires the board to offer a high deductible health benefit plan; provides employees participating in a deferred compensation plan the option of transferring those funds to a medical savings account.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2189** Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack Requires the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board to pay for medical services and treatment rendered by out-of-state hospitals at the same level paid to an in-state hospital if the insured employee was referred by a physician and it was the closest hospital to the employee's place of residence, unless the board has otherwise contracted with an out-of-state hospital.; Emergency. 01/08/96, Prefiled

**HB2190** Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack Clarifies language relating to the youth apprenticeship programs.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 01/08/96, Prefiled
