**HB1185** Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Thornbrugh, C. Michael Authorizes any sheriff's office or campus police agency to dispose of by public sale, destruction, donation, or transfer for use to a governmental subdivision personal property which has come into its possession; provides procedure for the same; establishes special funds to hold proceeds of the sale of such property and authorizes expenditures from said fund.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB1434** Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L.; Shurden, Frank Creates the Rural Economic Action Plan of 1996.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. **HB1672** Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Toure, Opio Modifies definitions of terms in the Employment Security Act of 1980; provides conditions under which an employee cannot be disqualified for benefits.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**HB2055** Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Williams, Don Modifies the determination, computation and procedures relating to the mid-term funding formula for schools.; Emergency. Second CCR Read - House, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate, Called Up For Consideration, Fourth Reading - Senate, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

**HB2059** Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura W.; Long, Ed Creates the Oklahoma Tuition Savings Account Act; provides aid and assistance in financing for postsecondary education; defines terms; allows residents to contribute to a tuition savings account not to exceed \$5,000; allows for adjustments in the Oklahoma taxable income and the Oklahoma adjusted gross income; provides for tax exemptions for contributions made after December 31, 1996.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Third CCR Submitted To House

**HB2065** Principal Author(s): Cox, Kevin; Hobson, Cal Creates the Oklahoma Athletic Trainers Act; modifies definition.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2143** Principal Author(s): Harrison, J. Berry; Taylor, Gary Modifies sunset date from July 1, 1996, to July 1, 2002, for the Plumbing Examiners, Water and Wastewater Works Advisory Council, Special Agency Account Board, Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters, EMS Advisory Council, Committee for Day Treatment Standards, Basic Health Benefits Board, Advisory Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse, and OETA.; Second CCR Submitted To House

**HB2172** Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M.; Maddox, James R. Modifies Oklahoma Pawnshop Act. Increases minimum net asset value for pawn shop investors from \$25,000 to \$50,000.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Motion To Adopt CCR, Motion Failed - House, CCR Failed - House

**HB2182** Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike; Stipe, Gene States legislative intent to protect the rights of child witnesses; defines terms; states considerations that must be considered before deciding to accept the testimony of a child witness; establishes who can be present during the testimony of a child witness; provides for accompaniment of a child witness during testimony.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2193** Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed Allows school districts to create their own educational improvement plan; deletes required components of said plan; allows districts to request an exemption from any statutory requirement or State Board rule not related to bilingual and special education programs, health and safety provisions, school finance, State Aid, pupil formula weights, teacher salary and teacher retirement, the Oklahoma School Testing Program and the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**HB2362** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Morgan, Fred Relates to financial privacy; provides exemptions from notice and challenge procedures; provides for customer non-notification; sets standards for the calculation of reasonable fees.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Referred To Conference Committee, Hb2362 (C)

**HB2379** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hendrick, Howard H. States that restricted driver's licenses shall become nonrenewable; provides conditions upon which restricted status may be removed.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2403** Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies deposits to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund to allocate 25% of each deposit as follows: 3/4 to the AG Evidence Fund and 1/4 to the AG Revolving Fund.; Emergency. CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, CCR Submitted To Senate, CCR Read - Senate

**HB2408** Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Harrison, J. Berry Modifies language relating to Rural Water, Sewer, Gas, and Solid Waste Management Districts Act.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2414** Principal Author(s): Kerr, Robert M.; Mitchell, Bill J. Prohibits transportation of oversize farm equipment by trailer on any highway during the hours of darkness.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate

**HB2548** Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Modifies language relating to the Department of Human Services and claims or payroll.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2584** Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Kerr, Robert M. Requires approval by county commissioners of the sale by auction of properties acquired by the county under the provisions of the resale tax laws.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2642** Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Mitchell, Bill J. Exempts the sale of Oklahoma Magazine and production of merchandise for resale from the Central Purchasing Act; states that specified services for the production of Oklahoma Today magazine shall also be exempt from said act; extends petty cash fund usage to include the payment of bank charges and the purchasing of beverage and vending licenses.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2796** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Smith, Jerry L. Provides that recordable instruments shall be written and printed in English and presented in a certain manner.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2824** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne Establishes appropriations to the State Board of Education for midterm supplements to State Aid to school districts from the Rainy Day Fund and makes other appropriations from the Rainy Day Fund.; Emergency. CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, CCR Submitted To Senate, CCR Read - Senate, Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House
