HB2959 Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce Provides tax credit against taxes imposed for direct investments by agricultural cooperative marketing associations in agricultural joint ventures created and designed to develop and advance the production, processing, handling and marketing of agricultural commodities grown, made or manufactured in Oklahoma.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2964 Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Changes the name of the Developmentally or Physically Disabled Persons Community Residential Living Act to teh Community Residential Living for Persons with Developmental Disabilities Act; transfers jurisdiction to the Department of Human Services; states that any related rules promulgated by the State Board of Health shall remain in effect until such rules are superseded by rules from the Commission for Human Services; provides for prior licensure of group homes.; Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2971 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ Clarifies language pertaining to the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System. Distinguishes adopted children from biological children with regard to beneficiaries. Defines beneficiary.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

HB2975 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ Prohibits requirement for filing paternity affidavits when consent for adoption has been given.; Emergency. CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, CCR Submitted To Senate, CCR Read - Senate

HJR1101 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Eddins, Joe Relates to certain rules of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services; disapproving certain rules; directing adoption of certain rules; directing distribution and declaring an emergency.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Engrossed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate

SB 74 Principal Author(s): Cole, Helen; Davis, Frank W. Relates to runaway children; adds runaway child to crime of contributing to delinquency; defines runaway child; criminalizes harbouring certain runaway children; provides penalty.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 658 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; Morgan, Fred Creates the Oklahoma Uniform Prudent Investor Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/95. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 680 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Stottlemire, Gary Prohibits bear wrestling exhibitions and horse tripping events; provides for punishment and fines for violation; allows the arresting law enforcement agency or animal control office to take custody of all animals in possession of the arrested person. Any person who commits any assault and battery against a current or former spouse, an individual with whom the defendant has had a child, or former resident of the defendant's household shall be guilty of domestic abuse punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding one year or a fine of \$2,000 or both. Subsequent convictions may include 2 years imprisonment and \$5,000 or both.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 685 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Leftwich, Keith Sets maximum speed and minimum speed limits for interstate and four-lane divided highways.; Emergency. SB 729 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Sullivan, Leonard Modifies language relating to licensure of used motor vehicle dealers and manufactured home dealers; modifies insurance requirements.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, Second CCR Submitted To House, Second CCR Read - House

SB 834 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne Appropriates funds from the Cash Flow Reserve Account to the State Board of Education.; Emergency. SB 1053 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Seikel, Mark Deletes all confidentiality and sealing requirements relating to juvenile records.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. SB 1106 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies sections pertaining to the Oklahoma State and Education Employee Group Insurance Board and the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council; prohibits the Board from offering a health plan which is owned or operated by the state and which utilizes a capitated payment plan for providers which uses a primary care physician as a gatekeeper to any specialty care provided by physician-specialists, unless specifically authorized by the Legislature.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.
