Relates to public finance; requires the disclosure of the identity of any public official or spouse that is an owner or operator or who is a principal of any legal entity which owns or operates a project or who has any financial interest, whether direct or indirect, in the project that no conflict of interest exists because of the public official's or any person who was public official during the immediately preceding 24 months; requires that a list of all political campaign contributions made in Oklahoma during the 48 months immediately preceding the submission of the application of all persons that will have a financial interest in the project.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HCR1102 Principal Author(s): Ervin, Mike; Haney, Enoch Kelly Designates the first full week of May as Suicide Prevention Awareness Week and directs distribution.; Called Up For Consideration, Adopted - House, Engrossed - House

SB 74 Principal Author(s): Cole, Helen; Davis, Frank W. Relates to runaway children; adds runaway child to crime of contributing to delinquency; defines runaway child; criminalizes harbouring certain runaway children; provides penalty.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, CCR Submitted To House

SB 679 Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Gustafson, Bill Provides a one-time tax credit for investments in qualified electric motor vehicle property placed in service after 12-31-95.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, CCR Submitted To House

SB 680 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Stottlemire, Gary Prohibits bear wrestling exhibitions and horse tripping events; provides for punishment and fines for violation; allows the arresting law enforcement agency or animal control office to take custody of all animals in possession of the arrested person. Any person who commits any assault and battery against a current or former spouse, an individual with whom the defendant has had a child, or former resident of the defendant's household shall be guilty of domestic abuse punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding one year or a fine of \$2,000 or both. Subsequent convictions may include 2 years imprisonment and \$5,000 or both.; Emergency. Motion To Table, Motion Adopted - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, CCR Submitted To House

SB 786 Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Herbert, Dave Authorizes Oklahoma Real Estate Commission to prescribe fees by rule. Removes the power of the Commission to have jurisdiction over persons who are no longer licensed. Requires persons who have active management control over persons required to be licensed to also possess a license as a real estate broker.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 788 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura W.; Hendrick, Howard H. Creates the License Perfursionists Act. Creates the State Board of Examiners of Perfursionists.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, CCR Submitted To House
