SB 947 Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Paulk, William R. Modifies procedures and provides for administrative fines and penalties for violations of the Alarm Industry Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, CCR Submitted To House

SB 989 Principal Author(s): Stipe, Gene; Vaughn, Ray Authorizes the Transportation Commission to create a State Infrastructure Bank for the purpose of pooling available federal, state, and private moneys to be dedicated for transportation infrastructure improvements.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, CCR Submitted To House

SB 1043 Principal Author(s): Roberts, Darryl F.; Settle, Bill Expands damages for injury to a right to or interest in water.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, CCR Submitted To House

SB 1050 Principal Author(s): Shurden, Frank; Stanley, Fred Modifies language relating to firearms.; Emergency. Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

SB 1053 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Seikel, Mark Deletes all confidentiality and sealing requirements relating to juvenile records.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, CCR Submitted To House

SB 1071 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Ed Lists student suspension options for students guilty of immorality or violation of school regulations; states that the suspended pupil may not be returned to the teacher's classroom without the teacher's consent or unless a district appeals committee determines that such placement is appropriate.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, CCR Submitted To House

SB 1167 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Steidley, Dwayne Provides regulations relating to simulcast races and fair associations licensed to conduct race meeting; clarifies days considered racing days. Provides for percentage of winnings to be received from wagering and provides for distribution of such moneys. States Oklahoma does not conduct live racing.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, CCR Submitted To House

SB 1223 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H. States that the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall have the power and duty to, in conjunction with the Oklahoma Medicaid Healthcare options system, review and evaluate State Medicaid Program eligibility and enrollment guidelines in relation to federal regulations.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, CCR Submitted To House

SB 1303 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Voskuhl, Sean Modifies membership of the Advisory Committee on Medical Care for Public Assistance Recipients.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, CCR Submitted To House

SCR 54 Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Kerr, Robert M.; Price, Bruce Memorializes the US Congress to enact laws or otherwise cause the IRS to provide relief for farmers regarding agricultural production deferral agreements and directing distribution.; . Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Agriculture (H)

SCR 58 Principal Author(s): Plunk, Bob; Wilkerson, Dick Recognizes the contributions of Mr. Ted Bird and the Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks.; . Called Up For Consideration, Adopted - House, Enrolled - Senate

SCR 60 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Shurden, Frank A Concurrent Resolution memorializing the president of the United States to direct the federal government to investigate the domestic cattle market.; . Second Reading - Referred To House Committee, Agriculture (H)

SCR 61 Principal Author(s): Mitchell, Bill J.; Weedn, Trish A Concurrent Resolution praising the life and achievements of Matthew Brent Hatcher; honoring his memory.; . House Introduction And First Reading

SR 51 Principal Author(s): Campbell, Grover Directs the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to conduct a study of the Academic Scholars Program.; . Called Up For Consideration, Adopted - Senate, Enrolled - Senate

SR 55 Principal Author(s): Stipe, Gene Supports the proposed merger of the Union Pacific and Southern Pacific Railroads.; . Referred Direct To Calendar, Laid Over - Senate

HB2089 Principal Author(s): Roberts, Larry; Monson, Angela; Modifies language relating to the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System.

HB2277 Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Herbert, Dave; Modifies language relating to the jurisdiction of cities and towns and the governing and regulating within the boundaries of that city or town.

HB2332 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Williams, Penny; Recodifies the Oklahoma Breast Cancer Act.

HB2494 Principal Author(s): Vaughn, Ray; Long, Ed; Modifies sections of the Prevention of Youth Access to Tobacco Act relevant to age of purchaser of tobacco products.

HB2603 Principal Author(s): Paulk, William; Weedn, Trish; Provides that any person who willfully or maliciously sets fire to, causes to be burned, or burns another person shall be guilty of arson in the first degree.

HB2621 Principal Author(s): Paulk, William; Dickerson, Larry; Enacts the state Employees Fair Labor Relations Act.

SB727 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard; Vaughn, Ray; Modifies language relating to the Uniform Tax Procedure Code to include judgements; requires that notices be sent to debtors; clarifies statutory reference.

SB745 Principal Author(s): Requires licensure of out-of-state physicians who regularly provide diagnos-

tic evaluations to in-state physicians or patients through electronic communications.

SB747 Principal Author(s): Snyder, Mark; Maddux, Elmer; Modifies vote required of beneficiary which is a county in order to waive certain competitive bidding requirements to two two thirds of the governing body.

SB749 Principal Author(s): Roberts, Darryl; Sadler, Al; Requires the Department of Veterans' Affairs to competitively bid any contract for the purpose of purchasing Part B Medicare products.

SB765 Principal Author(s) Weedn, Trish; Kirby, Ron; Authorizes the Department of Transportation to purchase individual safety recognition awards for its employees.
