## House Measures

**HB1238** Principal Author(s): Crocker, Ed; Easley, Kevin A. Relates to public finance; requires the disclosure of the identity of any public official or spouse that is an owner or operator or who is a principal of any legal entity which owns or operates a project or who has any financial interest, whether direct or indirect, in the project that no conflict of interest exists because of the public official's or any person who was public official during the immediately preceding 24 months; requires that a list of all political campaign contributions made in Oklahoma during the 48 months immediately preceding the submission of the application of all persons that will have a financial interest in the project.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**HB2053** Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Boyd, Laura W.; Brown, Ben; Cox, Kevin; Sadler, Al; Voskuhl, Sean; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies requirements for those involved in child abuse and neglect situations; requires criminal history investigations of foster parent applicants; provides for prompt medical treatment for abused children; provides for a special review application to be made after removing a child from custody; states that no child shall be placed in the custody of any individual subject to the Oklahoma

Sex Offenders Registration Act; provides for legal representation for abused children; transfers responsibility of removed children with the Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs; provides for review and approval of training curricula; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted, Second CCR Submitted To House

**HB2155** Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L. Allows for the possession, use, manufacturing, purchasing, installing, transportation and sale of chlorofluorocarbons.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Died In Conference

**HB2170** Principal Author(s): Hutchison, Joe J.; Shurden, Frank Changes quail season hunting dates to the first Saturday in November to January 31.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, CCR Read - Senate

**HB2332** Principal Author(s): Boyd, Betty; Williams, Penny Recodifies the Oklahoma Breast Cancer Act.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2494** Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Vaughn, Ray Modifies sections of the Prevention of Youth Access to Tobacco Act relevant to age of purchaser of

tobacco products. Provides penalties.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2553** Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Seikel, Mark Relates to the Agents Licensing Act; deletes surplus line insurance brokers from licensing requirements; adds fraternal agents to licensing requirements; modifies language and fees; modifies educational requirements.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, CCR Read - Senate

**HB2603** Principal Author(s): Paulk, William R.; Weedn, Trish Provides that any person who willfully or maliciously sets fire to, causes to be burned, or burns another person shall be guilty of arson in the first degree.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB3037** Principal Author(s): Ford, Charles R.; Perry, Fred Requires environmental agencies to promulgate rules to establish penalties to be imposed against any person who knowingly makes a false complaint or who knowingly misrepresents or omits material information relating to the complaint.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill Passed
