**HB2346** Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny Directs the Commissioner of Public Safety to require a gas cap integrity test for motor vehicles.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2348** Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny Provides coverage requirement for health benefit plans as they relate to maternity coverage.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2362** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Morgan, Fred Relates to financial privacy; provides exemptions from notice and challenge procedures; provides for customer non-notification; sets standards for the calculation of reasonable fees.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2373** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hobson, Cal Eliminates certain financial responsibilities of the State Treasurer; authorizes the State Treasurer to accept deposits directly into state treasury funds; deletes certain fees collected by the State Treasurer; deletes the requirement for the State Treasurer to provide indemnifying bonds.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2374** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Monson, Angela Creates the Workplace and Employee Protection Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2379** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hendrick, Howard H. States that restricted driver's licenses shall become nonrenewable; provides conditions upon which restricted status may be removed.; Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2385** Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Requires confidentiality for review of ethical complaints for determining qualified corporations.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2403** Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies deposits to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund to allocate 25% of each deposit as follows: 3/4 to the AG Evidence Fund and 1/4 to the AG Revolving Fund.; Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2416** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Allows an equal number of years of employment with the Corporation Commission as a field inspector to qualify an applicant for employment with the Conservation Commission for positions requiring experience in the production of oil and gas.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2422** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Proposes to modify sections pertaining to the calculation of retirement benefits within the

Teachers' Retirement System.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2463** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Dunegan, James H. Modifies date to 1997 relating to required FTE recommendations from the Human Resources Management Advisory Committee.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2466** Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed Amends language relating to a teacher's right to due process and compensation or benefits when a board of education receives a superintendent's recommendation for a teacher's dismissal unless the career teacher is convicted of a felony.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2475** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies the time which each state agency participating in the Group Insurance Plans shall pay to the State Employees Group Insurance Clearing Fund a specified amount to the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2483** Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Shurden, Frank Updates language pertaining to the powers of the State Board of Agriculture.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2494** Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Vaughn, Ray Modifies sections of the Prevention of Youth Access to Tobacco Act relevant to age of purchaser of tobacco products. Provides penalties.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill Passed - House, Enrolled - House

**HB2497** Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H. Deletes obsolete language pertaining to the Oklahoma State Employees Benefit Council.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2501** Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Cain, Bernest Modifies powers and duties of the Department of Human Services, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority and the Oklahoma Medicaid Program Integrity Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2512** Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Transfers authority over the Oklahoma Office of Volunteerism from the Office of the Secretary of State to the Department of Civil Emergency Management; Creates the Oklahoma Commission on Volunteerism; directs the Office of the Secretary of State to provide staff support; states powers and duties.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

**HB2547** Principal Author(s): Seikel, Mark; Snyder, Mark Deletes limitations on expenditures for salaries and wages of county officers.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House, CCR Rejected

**HB2548** Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Modifies language relating to the Department of Human Services and claims or payroll.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2559** Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Weaver, Robert E. Provides for investment of funds from prepaid funeral benefit contracts.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Died In Conference

**HB2603** Principal Author(s): Paulk, William R.; Weedn, Trish Provides that any person who willfully or maliciously sets fire to, causes to be burned, or burns another person shall be guilty of arson in the first degree.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Read - Senate, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Enrolled - House

**HB2617** Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Paulk, William R. Provides for crimes against witnesses, persons attending official proceedings, and informants.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2621** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William R. Enacts the State Employees Fair Labor Relations Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2648** Principal Author(s): Mitchell, Bill J.; Monson, Angela Requires the Oklahoma Department of Health to establish and enforce standards and requirements for the Home Health Care Act. Requires an annual report and a certificate of need for home health care agencies. Stipulates conditions and actions prior to issuance of certificate of need. Provides process and conditions for opposition and specifies penalties to be charged with a misdemeanor and fined between \$100 and \$500.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2671** Principal Author(s): Johnson, Glen D.; Taylor, Stratton Enacts the "State Employee Pay Evaluation Act of 1996".; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2692** Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Fisher, Ted V. Places the Juvenile Justice Advisory and Oversight Committee under the supervision of the Office of Juvenile Affairs; states that the amount of a juvenile's earnings designated for restitution to victims shall be placed in the Juvenile Restitution Revolving Fund; states that acquisitions or purchases of clothing for juveniles or acquisitions of food for group homes under the custody of the Office of Juvenile Affairs shall be exempt from the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act; expands provisional scope to include purchases from such funds received by offices administered by the Office of Juvenile Affairs.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.
