**HB2735** Principal Author(s): Fair, Mike; Ferguson, Larry R.; Pope, Tim Clarifies language relating to the civil rights of prisoners.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2748** Principal Author(s): Plunk, Bob; Wilkerson, Dick Allows for a tax deduction for the amount of tuition paid by a taxpayer to a public or private Oklahoma college or university; limits deduction to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00); exempts deduction allowance for grants, scholarships, stipends, employer reimbursements or tuition waivers.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2755** Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Coleman, Carolyn Requires the Department of Juvenile Justice to provide a uniform system of assessment of the reading ability of each juvenile upon initial placement in an institution or facility.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2782** Principal Author(s): Steidley, Dwayne; Taylor, Stratton Creates the State Employees Compensation System Reform Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2802** Principal Author(s): Littlefield, Rick; Seikel, Mark Establishes the levels of care given to residents of nursing facilities, specialized facilities and residential care homes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Died In Conference

**HB2806** Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Cain, Bernest Allows any consumer reporting agency to contact DHS to request information as to whether a specified person is required to pay child support.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2812** Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Capps, Gilmer N. Clarifies language pertaining to the issuance of and qualification for a restricted commercial vehicle driver's license to persons under seventeen years of age for custom harvest purposes.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2852** Principal Author(s): Johnson, Glen D.; Taylor, Stratton Creates the "Governmental Powers Clarification Act"; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2856** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Creates the Oklahoma Underground Storage Tank Regulation Act; creates the Underground Storage Tank Regulation Program for the implementation of said act.; Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2861** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Peltier, Wanda Jo; Roberts, Larry D. Provides for child support and qualified domestic orders in relation to

state retirement.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2874** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Modifies definitions to include natural gas; increases the membership of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board from eighteen (18) to thirty (30); decreases membership of said board to twenty-four (24) after Jul. 1, 1996 and provides for reapportionment of members; modifies the assessment to be levied for board funding from two cents per barrel (\$0.02) to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the gross revenues received at the wellhead for oil, natural gas, casing-head gas or condensate; increases amount retained by the board from One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000); Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2887** Principal Author(s): Settle, Bill; Williams, Don Authorizes the State Regents for Higher Education to administer the student loan guarantee program under the federal Higher Education Act of 1965; authorizes the Regents to make collection efforts.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2890** Principal Author(s): Settle, Bill; Smith, Jerry L. Modifies authorized expenditures pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act as it pertains to various state agencies.; Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2893** Principal Author(s): Fisher, Ted V.; Settle, Bill Creates the Oklahoma Limited Liability Partnership Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2938** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Hamilton, James E. Clarifies language to the Oklahoma Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Act. Allows the Attorney General to recover costs and expenses of litigation and attorney fees for representation relating to the environment and natural resources.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2946** Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies statutory reference relating to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2953** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Seikel, Mark Clarifies legislative intent regarding reporting obligations within the Oklahoma Child Abuse Reporting and Prevention Act.; Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2959** Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce Provides tax credit against taxes imposed for direct investments by agricultural cooperative marketing associations in agricultural joint ventures created and designed to develop and advance the production, processing, handling and marketing of agricultural commodities grown, made or manufactured in Okla-

homa.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2960** Principal Author(s): Seikel, Mark; Weedn, Trish Directs DHS to cooperate with and help promote foster parent associations in each county; provide additional services relating to the placement of children in foster care; develop a policy of accident, personal liability, and automobile liability insurance; and develop a procedure to determine the ability of parents to pay part or all of the costs for foster care.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2964** Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Changes the name of the Developmentally or Physically Disabled Persons Community Residential Living Act to the Community Residential Living for Persons with Developmental Disabilities Act; transfers jurisdiction to the Department of Human Services; states that any related rules promulgated by the State Board of Health shall remain in effect until such rules are superseded by rules from the Commission for Human Services; provides for prior licensure of group homes.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2969** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Seikel, Mark Directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to amend the state Medicaid plan to provide a funding source for payment of temporary managers or state monitors in facilities certified to provide long-term care services and community-based service provider facility under Medicaid.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2972** Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny Creates the Oklahoma Voluntary Remediation and Redevelopment Act, which encourages voluntary remediation of contaminated sites by limiting the liability of property owners; fosters reuse of property previously contaminated and establishes a voluntary site remediation program to assist property owners.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2975** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ Prohibits requirement for filing paternity affidavits when consent for adoption has been given.; Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2986** Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Long, Ed Modifies language relating to the Oklahoma Child Care Facilities Licensing Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

**HB2988** Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Muegge, Paul Authorizes the State Board of Agriculture to establish fees; provides for other surety allowable for livestock markets by the US Packers and Stockyards Act; and provides penalties upon the suspension, revocation, or expiration of livestock auction market licenses. Defines livestock and exotic animals.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House
