HB2989 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Muegge, Paul Creates the Livestock Dealers Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - House

HB2990 Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Creates the "Oklahoma Centralized Support Registry Act" to regulate the payment of all child support, spousal support and other related payments.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - House

HB3008 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Cain, Bernest Directs the Department of Corrections to not house or process inmates at the facility located at 1411 North Classen Boulevard in Oklahoma City. States that no inmate shall be allowed to enter or remain in the building or on the grounds of the building, unless the inmate is under the direct supervision of DOC personnel.; Emergency. Requires Corporation Commission to provide notices and rules.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. SB 232 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Modifies reference to the State of Oklahoma in

52 O.S. 1991, Section 1.1, relating to natural gas corporations.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 587 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Paulk, William R. Includes advanced practice nurses in list of medical practitioners included in definition of prescription; includes advanced practice nurses in definition of licensed practitioner; specifies that advanced registered nurse practitioners, clinical nurse specialists, certified nurse-midwives, certified registered nurse anesthetist, and advanced practice nurses such nurses may not dispense drugs but may dispense professional samples; allows such nurses to diagnose, prescribe, distribute, and administer medicines, devices, or treatments as defined by the Board of Nursing; requires such nurses practitioners to accept responsibility to practice in accepted manner for their profession.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 611 Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce Prohibits the Department of Corrections from entering into a contract with any private prison facility for the incarceration of state inmates when the design and construction of the facility does not meet stipulated requirements.; Emergency. SB 622 Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies various provisions pertaining to the needs of people with severe disabilities.; Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, Third CCR Read - Senate, CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested

SB 679 Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Gustafson, Bill Provides a one-time tax credit for investments in qualified electric motor vehicle property placed in service after 12-31-95.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 681 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Williams, Penny Modifies the amount of annual household income required for homestead exemptions from \$10,000 to \$15,000; clarifies gender references.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 682 Principal Author(s): Dank, Odilia; Hendrick, Howard H. Modifies property exemptions from ad valorem taxation.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate

SB 685 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Leftwich, Keith Sets maximum speed and minimum speed limits for interstate and four-lane divided highways.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 694 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Hutchison, Joe J. Adds county boards and public trust authorities to provisions allowing dual office holding.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 701 Principal Author(s): Cole, Helen; Davis, Frank W. Prohibits the sale, delivery, or furnishing of low-point beer to an intoxicated person.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Referred To Conference Committee, Sb0701 (C)

SB 703 Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Hendrick, Howard H. Modifies procedure for interpreting statutes and agency rules under the Administrative Procedures Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 727 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; Vaughn, Ray Modifies language relating to the Uniform Tax Procedure Code to include judgments; requires that notices be sent to debtors; clarifies statutory reference.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 729 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Sullivan, Leonard Modifies language relating to licensure of used motor vehicle dealers and manufactured home dealers; modifies insurance requirements.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

Modifies language and statutory references relating to assessment and valuation of property; requires county assessors to assess specified improvements based on fair market value.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.
