SB 749 Principal Author(s): Roberts, Darryl F.; Sadler, Al Requires the Department of Veterans Affairs to competitively bid any contract for the purpose of purchasing Part B Medicare products.; Effective Date: 09/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 765 Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M.; Weedn, Trish Authorizes Department of Transportation to purchase individual safety recognition awards for its employees.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Senate Concurred With House Amendments, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Enrolled - Senate

SB 782 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H. Creates the Oklahoma Telecommunications Authority Board.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 788 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura W.; Hendrick, Howard H. Creates the License Perfusionists Act. Creates the State Board of Examiners of Perfusionists.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 798 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Weaver, Robert E. Provides for a Crime Victims Awareness License Plate; provides that \$20.00 of the \$25.00 fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Crime Victims Center.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 836 Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly; Hobson, Cal; Steidley, Dwayne Appropriates funds to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from the Cash Flow Reserve Fund.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - Senate, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House

SB 852 Principal Author(s): Littlefield, Rick; Miller, Doug Relates to the State Travel Reimbursement Act; removes exception for dentists and other health care professionals from standard method for computing per diem.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 854 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Ford, Charles R.; Williams, Penny Creates the Oklahoma Capitol Complex Centennial Commission; provides that beginning June 30, 1997, the Legislature should

appropriate \$2.5 million annually for the next consecutive 10 years to fund the commission.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 859 Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Williams, Don Includes weather modification in a list of designated purposes for county sales tax.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 869 Principal Author(s): Haney, Enoch Kelly; Steidley, Dwayne Requires the Director of the Office of State Finance to make copies of all agency budget work programs and notice of budget work program revisions to the Joint Legislative Committee on Budget and Program Oversight.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Referred To Conference Committee

SB 871 Principal Author(s): Glover, Jim R.; Helton, Sam States that the governing body of a municipality may authorize the CEO of the municipality to respond to any request from any other jurisdiction within one state for law enforcement assistance in cases of emergency.; Emergency. CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House

SB 873 Principal Author(s): Hilliard, Danny; Roberts, Darryl F. States that the salaries and travel reimbursement of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor and the Legislature shall be withheld for the period of time any state employee is furloughed as a direct result of he failure of the Governor and the Legislature to enact appropriations measures; Effective Date: 11/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 876 Principal Author(s): Culver, Bob Ed; Rozell, Herb Authorizes the Scenic Rivers Commission to acquire additional property for the development and maintenance of scenic river areas.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 886 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam Provides for special license plates for police officers.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Senate Concurred With House Amendments, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Enrolled - Senate

SB 891 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Provides additional years of participating service for employees terminated due to a reduction in force due to privatization or loss of federal revenue.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 895 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Provides that 10% of all costs collected by the court clerk and deposited in the Indigent Defense System Revolving Fund shall be retained by the court clerk as an administrative fee with the remaining 90% being transmitted to the state Treasurer who shall credit the amount to the Indigent Defense System Revolving Fund.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 896 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Transfers various powers and authorities of the State Employees Benefits Council from the Health Care Authority to the Council itself.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 899 Principal Author(s): Fields, Lloyd; Littlefield, Rick Adds definitions for "progressive game" and "special promotional game" to the Oklahoma Charity Games Act; exempts religious, charitable, labor, fraternal and educational organizations from the definition of "organization;" states the price for an employee license shall be \$5.00; states that an organization licensed to conduct charity games may remit a monthly equivalent amount of tax to the Oklahoma Tax Commission in lieu of paying the distributor for taxes levied.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. SB 901 Principal Author(s): Hastings, Chris; Smith, Jerry L. Includes dishonored checks written for child support or support alimony in definition of false or bogus checks.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 906 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Clarifies language relating to the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Referred To Conference Committee

SB 908 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Leftwich, Keith Prohibits general enrollment fees or nonresident tuition to be charged to children of any employees of the State of Oklahoma who have given their lives in the line of duty.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 910 Principal Author(s): Fields, Lloyd; Monson, Angela Clarifies languages pertaining to the Oklahoma State and Education Employees Group Insurance Act, the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Act, and the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 911 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Defines "economically at-risk wells" to include any oil or natural gas producing property which produces 3 barrels or less of oil or 30,000 cubic feet of gas per day unless the weighted average wellhead price of Oklahoma oil exceeds \$20 calculated on an annual calendar year basis or the weighted average wellhead price of Oklahoma gas exceeds \$2.50 per Million British Thermal Units calculated on an annual calendar year basis.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.
