SB 914 Principal Author(s): Shurden, Frank; Smith, Bill Prohibits the headlighting of feral animals.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Senate Concurred With House Amendments, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Enrolled - Senate

SB 921 Principal Author(s): Weaver, Robert E.; Wilkerson, Dick Repeals various sections pertaining to sales and income taxes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 931 Principal Author(s): Taylor, Gary; Williams, Penny Creates the Oklahoma Clearinghouse for International Trade.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 941 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Clarifies language pertaining to the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 944 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; McCorkell, Don Jr. Enacts the Literacy Improvement Act of 1996; establishes requirements for the Department of Juvenile Justice or county juvenile bureau to conduct a pre-adjudicator literacy skill assessment and make that assessment available to the court in the disposition phase.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 947 Principal Author(s): Leftwich, Keith; Paulk, William R. Modifies procedures and provides for administrative fines and penalties for violations of the Alarm Industry Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 959 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Creates the Natural Gas Competitiveness Act of 1996; limits authority of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission as it relates to natural gas.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 974 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Leist, M. C. Requires transporters of waste, wastewater, or sludge to develop and maintain manifests.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 976 Principal Author(s): Bell, Jack; Erwin, Randall L. Promotes the goals of the Oklahoma Recycling Initiative; states ownership of recoverable materials; prohibits government units from restricting donations or sales of recoverable materials.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 981 Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Kerr, Robert M. Deletes weight limit provisions pertaining to vehicles delivering agricultural commodities weighed as a single draft.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Senate Concurred With House Amendments, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House

SB 987 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Stipe, Gene Provides exception for the Department of Transportation pursuant to disclosure of terms of bids. Requires the department to publish all engineering estimates at least 10 days prior to the bid submission closing date.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. Governor Action - Veto, Veto Message Read - Senate

SB 988 Principal Author(s): Dunegan, James H.; Stipe, Gene Requires Dept. of Transportation to issue permits for multi-state oversize and overweight vehicles. Designates specific routes for vehicles operating under such permits.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 989 Principal Author(s): Stipe, Gene; Vaughn, Ray Authorizes the Transportation Commission to create a State Infrastructure Bank for the purpose of pooling available federal, state, and private moneys to be dedicated for transportation infrastructure improvements.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 993 Principal Author(s): Hastings, Chris; Smith, Jerry L. States that an owner who has sold or transferred the ownership of a vehicle and who has delivered the vehicle to the purchaser or transferee shall not be civilly or criminally liable for the parking, abandonment, or operation of the vehicle by another after the sale.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 996 Principal Author(s): Roberts, Darryl F.; Stanley, Fred Requires voters to sign a precinct registry before being issued a ballot.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 1000 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Modifies language and statutory references relating to the Retail Electric Supplier Certified Territory Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 1007 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; Vaughn, Ray Adds housing, food and clothing to the cost of prisoner incarceration; states that a defendant may be required to reimburse the jail facility for the cost of incarceration as a condition of bail.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 1012 Principal Author(s): Ferguson, Larry R.; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Provides for the immediate deportation of non U.S. citizens who are received into the custody of the Department of Corrections.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 1017 Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Shurden, Frank States that the Troop Commander in charge of a highway patrol troop may designate specified portions of federal aid primary highways and the state highway system in the service area of the troop.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House

SB 1024 Principal Author(s): Bonny, Jack; Price, Bruce Provides for Oklahoma Department of Commerce support of international trade relationships.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 1031 Principal Author(s): Rozell, Herb; Sadler, Al Broadens the authority of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission to levy specified administrative fines against used car dealers; defines consignment sale; redefines used car salesman.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 1032 Principal Author(s): Hutchison, Joe J.; Littlefield, Rick Allows any eligible employer of a municipality which is a participating employer in the Oklahoma Public Employees Pension and Retirement System on July 1, 1996 to become a participating municipality of the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System on Sept. 1 1996, only if certified copy of a resolution approved by the governing body of the eligible employer or by any other body or officer authorized by law or recognized by the State Board to approve such a resolution and assure that it is filed with the State Board by August 15, 1996. Such election shall be irrevocable. States additional eligibility requirements.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 1043 Principal Author(s): Roberts, Darryl F.; Settle, Bill Expands damages for injury to a right to or interest in water.; Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 1050 Principal Author(s): Shurden, Frank; Stanley, Fred Modifies language relating to firearms.; Emergency. CCR-CCS Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 1053 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Seikel, Mark Deletes all confidentiality and sealing requirements relating to juvenile records.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 1061 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick States that any order directing a defendant to pay costs of representation shall be a lien against all real and personal property of the defendant and may be filed against such property as provided by law for such liens.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate

SB 1062 Principal Author(s): Rice, Larry; Wilkerson, Dick Allows for the establishment of a crimes information unit within the Oklahoma Bureau of Investigation.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Senate Concurred With House Amendments, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Enrolled - Senate

SB 1071 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Ed Lists student suspension options for students guilty of immorality or violation of school regulations; states that the suspended pupil may not be returned to the teacher's classroom without the teacher's consent or unless a district appeals committee determines that such placement is appropriate.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Submitted, CCR Read - Senate
