Allows officers or employees of a municipality with a population of more than 2,500 to conduct business with said municipality; allows members of any board of education of a municipality with a population of over 2,500 to furnish materials or supplies to said municipality; allows members of any board of education within a municipality with a population of more than 2,500 to vote on contracts between area vocational-technical schools and the entity by which the member is employed.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Requires agency relationship of bank holding companies, branches, and affiliates banks to be consistent with banking practices and regulations.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. **HB2250** Principal Author(s): Paulk, William R.; Snyder, Mark Relates to the Plumbing License Law of 1955; directs the State Board of Health, through the Commissioner of Health, to promulgate rules governing the adoption of standards for plumbing published by a nationally recognized code body for the establishment of a minimum standard of plumbing installation in this state; modifies language, exempting individuals who perform plumbing work on their own residence.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**HB2271** Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Douglass, Brooks Increases minimum payments and assessments related to victim compensation.; Emergency. Third CCR Submitted To House, Third CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, Third CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Third CCR Submitted To Senate, Third CCR Read - Senate

**HB2294** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Shurden, Frank Authorizes Wildlife Conservation to sell advertising in any publication, media production or other informational material it produces.; Emergency. **HB2361** Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Weaver, Robert E. Allows investments to be made by banking institution trust departments.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Third CCR Submitted To House, Third CCR Read - House

**HB2362** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Morgan, Fred Relates to financial privacy; provides exemptions from notice and challenge procedures; provides for customer non-notification; sets standards for the calculation of reasonable fees.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Motion To Reconsider - Senate

**HB2373** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hobson, Cal Eliminates certain financial responsibilities of the State Treasurer; authorizes the State Treasurer to accept deposits directly into state treasury funds; deletes certain fees collected by the State Treasurer; deletes the requirement for the State Treasurer to provide indemnifying bonds.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

**HB2374** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Monson, Angela Creates the Workplace and Employee Protection Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**HB2393** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Seikel, Mark Creates the Early Identification and Service Support for Children and Families Act; modifies duties of the Joint Legislative Committee for Review of Coordination of Services to Children and Youth. Changes name of Legislative committee and provides for the results of early screening procedures.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Third CCR Submitted To House, Third CCR Read - House

**HB2403** Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies deposits to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund to allocate 25% of each deposit as follows: 3/4 to the AG Evidence Fund and 1/4 to the AG Revolving Fund.; Emergency. **HB2414** Principal Author(s): Kerr, Robert M.; Mitchell, Bill J. Prohibits transportation of oversize farm equipment by trailer on any highway during the hours of darkness.; Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

**HB2416** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Allows an equal number of years of employment with the Corporation Commission as a field inspector to qualify an applicant for employment with the Conservation Commission for positions requiring experience in the production of oil and gas.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.
