SB 993 Principal Author(s): Hastings, Chris; Smith, Jerry L. States that an owner who has sold or transferred the ownership of a vehicle and who has delivered the vehicle to the purchaser or transferee shall not be civilly or criminally liable for the parking, abandonment, or operation of the vehicle by another after the sale. Modifies duties of the Oklahoma Tax Commission and moto license agents; requires training of personnel authorized to perform inspections and examinations; modifies time at which certain fee required to be paid and modifies apportionment thereof; prohibiting suit against certain agencies and persons liable for certain acts; requires the Department of promulgate rules; provides an effective date and declares an emergency.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Second CCR Submitted To House, Second CCR Read - House

SB 996 Principal Author(s): Roberts, Darryl F.; Stanley, Fred Requires voters to sign a precinct registry before being issued a ballot.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Read - Senate, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, Second CCR Submitted To House, Second CCR Read - House

SB 1002 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H. Provides additional basis for the issuance of a specified certificate from the Oklahoma Corporation Commission.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Second CCR Submitted To House, Second CCR Read - House

SB 1031 Principal Author(s): Rozell, Herb; Sadler, Al Broadens the authority of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission to levy specified administrative fines against used car dealers; defines consignment sale; redefines used car salesman.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Third CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Second CCR Submitted To House, Second CCR Read - House

SB 1043 Principal Author(s): Roberts, Darryl F.; Settle, Bill Expands damages for injury to a right to or interest in water.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Motion Prevailed - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill Passed - House, Emergency Failed - House, Signed & Returned To Senate, Enrolled - Senate

SB 1061 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick States that any order directing a defendant to pay costs of representation shall be a lien against all real and personal property of the defendant and may be filed against such property as provided by law for such liens.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 1071 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Ed Lists student suspension options for students guilty of immorality or violation of school regulations; states that the suspended pupil may not be returned to the teacher's classroom without the teacher's consent or unless a district appeals committee determines that such placement is appropriate.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 1080 Principal Author(s): Seikel, Mark; Snyder, Mark Requires that a complete disclosure of name, mailing address and finding address of every stockholder with at least five percent ownership shall be included with each hospice license application.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

SB 1087 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Makes \$40.00 per month fee for persons with a deferred prosecution program supervised by the Probation and Parole Division of the Department of Corrections.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Motion To Reconsider - House

SB 1100 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Williams, Don Directs property taxes of railroads and public service corporations shall be paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission and states that all others shall be paid to the appropriate county treasurer; states that such taxes paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be deposited into Protested Ad Valorem Tax Revolving Fund; removes due date for payment; replaces references to Head Start programs with language relating to free or reduced lunches as it relates to admission into early childhood programs; deletes specified contents of report to the governor; deletes probationary accreditation requirements; modifies authority of the State Department of Education; provides for emergency school transfers; modifies midterm funding; provides for pupil removal from class; creates the Oklahoma Accountability System; creates the Technology Endowment Fund; authorizes the State Board of Education to award Statewide Alternative Education Program Grants; directs the board to promulgate rules establishing the Oklahoma Advanced Placement Incentive Program; provides funding for teacher bonus programs; repeals sections.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. SB 1115 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies statutory references relating to drivers licenses, motorcycle safety instruction permits, and special motorcycle permits.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 1130 Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William R. States that state employee payroll deductions shall be made for membership dues or contributions to a foundation in the Oklahoma Public Employees Association or any other statewide asso-

ciation limited to state employee membership with a minimum membership of 1,000 dues-paying members.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Third CCR Submitted To Senate, Third CCR Read - Senate, Called Up For Consideration, Third CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Third CCR Submitted To House, Third CCR Read - House

SB 1147 Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Shedrick, Bernice Prohibits the use of accident reports for commercial purposes.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Governor Action - Signed

SB 1175 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Cain, Bernest Excludes collection of child support from statute of limitations; provides for liens against property; prevents child support from becoming dormant for any purpose. Clarifies language of bill regarding child support.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Governor Action - Signed

SB 1177 Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Williams, Penny Provides that any license holder of a nursing home who has been cited more than three times for deficiencies which lead to enforcement action and penalties, or found to be out of substantial compliance with the requirements of any statute or rule, will not be deemed a person responsible or suitable to operate or direct such a facility.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate

SB 1184 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Kerr, Robert M. Creates the Alternative School Program providing, in addition to classroom instruction, 24 hour per day, 7 days per week supervision for certain juveniles.; Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate

SB 1192 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Herbert, Dave Creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Act; creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Advisory Committee within the Department of Transportation; creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Revolving Fund.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

SB 1200 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Rozell, Herb Authorizes the establishment of drug courts in the district courts of the state; provides for funding.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Third CCR Submitted To Senate, Called Up For Consideration, Third CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, Third CCR Submitted To House, Third CCR Read - House

SB 1209 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam Modifies references relating to vehicle inspection fees.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Third CCR Submitted To Senate, Third CCR Read - Senate, Third CCR Rejected - House, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted
