SB 1215 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Hutchison, Joe J. States that no person shall operate any vessel on any waters in the state while under the influence of any substance listed in the Uniformed Controlled Substances Act or any combination of alcohol and said substance; authorizes the Grand River Dam Authority to set maximum lake speed limits; states that no person shall operate any vessel on any waters of the state, except those that are privately owned, at speeds in excess of those established.; Emergency. SB 1223 Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Robinson, Ben H. States that the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall have the power and duty to, in conjunction with the Oklahoma Medicaid Healthcare options system, review and evaluate State Medicaid Program eligibility and enrollment guidelines in relation to federal regulations.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. SB 1227 Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Stanley, Fred Relating to state government; allowing certain entities to participate in the State and Education Employees Group Health and Life Insurance plans under certain circumstances; modifies group of retirees allowed to participate in the dental insurance plan; and provides for an effective date; declares an emergency.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Berry; Modifies sunset date from July 1, 1996 to July 1, 2002, for the Plumbing Examiners, Water and Wastewater Works Advisory Council; recreates the Advisory Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse, and OETA; creates the Advisory Commission on Latin American and Hispanic Affairs. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

HB2483 Principal Author(s): Leist, M.C.; Shurden, Frank; Updates language pertaining to the powers of the State Board of Agriculture. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

HB2512 Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Wright, Ged; Transfers authority over the Oklahoma Office of Volunteerism from the Office of the Secretary of State to the Department of Civil Emergency Management; Creates the Oklahoma Commission on Volunteerism; directs the Office of the Secretary of State to provide staff support; states powers and duties. **SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/23/96)**

HB2553 Principal Author(s): Seikel, Mark; Robinson, Ben; Deletes surplus line insurance brokers from licensing requirements; adds fraternal agents to licensing requirements; modifies language, fees and educational requirements. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

HB2692 Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd; Fisher, Ted; Places the Juvenile Justice Advisory and Oversight Committee under the supervision of the Office of Juvenile Affairs; states that the amount of a juvenile's earning designated for restitution to victims shall be placed in the Juvenile Restitution Revolving Fund; states that acquisitions or purchases of clothing
