HB3008 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Cain, Bernest; Directs the Department of Corrections to not house or process inmates at the facility located at 1411 North Classen Boulevard in Oklahoma City. States that no inmate shall be allowed to enter or remain in the building or on the grounds of the building, unless the inmate is under the direct supervision of DOC personnel. **SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/23/96)**

SB1061 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick; States that any order directing a defendant to pay costs of representation shall be alien against all real and personal property of the defendant and may be filed against such property as provided by law for such liens. **SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/23/96)**

SB1071 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry; Long, Ed; Lists student suspension options for student guilty of immorality or violation of school regulations; states that the suspended pupil may not be returned to the teacher's classroom without the teacher's consent or unless a district appeals committee determines that such placement is appropriate. **SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/23/96)**

SB1106 Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Roberts, Larry D.; Modifies sections pertaining to the Oklahoma State and Education Employee Group Insurance Board and the Oklahoma State Employee Group Insurance Board and the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council. **SIGNED AND TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/22/96)**

SB1115 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Weaver, Robert; Modifies statutory reference relating to drivers licenses, motorcycle safety instruction permits, and special motorcycle permits. **SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/23/96)**

SB1192 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry; Herbert, Dave; Creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Act; creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Advisory Committee within the Department of Transportation; creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Revolving Fund. **SIGNED & TRANSMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR - (05/23/96)**

HB1088 Provides for the deduction from OK adjusted gross income any medical expenses incurred in the process of adoption of a minor. **(05/23/96)**

HB1185 Authorizes any sheriff's office or campus police agency to dispose of by public sale, destruction, donation or transfer for use to a governmental subdivision personal property which has come into its possession; provides procedure for the same; establishes special funds to hold proceeds of the sale of such property and authorizes expenditures from said fund. **(05/21/96)**

HB1268 Relates to environment and natural resources; provides regulations and restrictions relating

to recycling facilities. Eng. Sen. Amend. strikes the title. **(04/09/96)**

HB1434 Creates the Rural Economic Action Plan of 1996. **(05/20/96)**

HB1555 Relates to state government; authorizes purchases of certain non-medical, assistive technology - related items by State Department of Rehabilitative Services without competitive bid requirements. **(05/01/96)**

HB1621 Modifies language relating to income tax; allowing private sector employees to claim a tax exemption on benefits. **(05/23/96)**

HB1777 Relates to the chief executive offices; makes appropriations to the offices of the governor and lieutenant governor. **(05/23/96)**

HB1817 Authorizes expenditures from certain funds for certain purposes and limits the salary of the Director of the Department of Central Services; exempts certain employees from the merit system of Personnel Administration. **(03/26/96)**

HB1860 Relates to motor vehicles; doubles fines for speeding in construction zones. **(04/29/96)**

HB1880 Clarifies language relating to the dental profession. Creates and sets qualifications for a Board
