**HB1374** Principal Author(s): Shurden, Frank; Stanley, Fred Enacts the Oklahoma Handgun Licensing Act; allows persons to carry a concealed pistol or revolver when issued a handgun license.; Effective Date: 09/01/95. Davis Memorial Commission and the Will Rogers Memorial Commission.; Effective Date: 09/01/96. Governor Action - Signed

**HB1780** Principal Author(s): Hamilton, James E.; Haney, Enoch Kelly Makes an appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technol-

ogy; makes those appropriations subject to fiscal year limitations.; Effective Date: 09/01/96. Governor Action - Line Item Veto
