SB 895 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Relates to appointment of counsel for indigent minors, parents, or guardians; amends language relating to the Indigent Defense Act; deletes language requiring Indigent Defense System representation of indigents or non-criminal proceedings; requires court to appoint certain attorneys for representation of certain indigent defendants and directs attorneys fees to be paid from local court fund; allows Indigent Defense to award contracts for perfection of certain appeals and provides an effective date.; Effective Date: 11/01/96 Emergency. Games Act; exempts religious, charitable, labor, fraternal and educational organizations from the definition of "organization;" states the price for an employee license shall be \$5.00; states that an organization licensed to conduct charity games may remit a monthly equivalent amount of tax to the Oklahoma Tax Commission in lieu of paying the distributor for taxes levied.; Effective Date: 07/01/96. SB 993 Principal Author(s): Hastings, Chris; Smith, Jerry L. States that an owner who has sold or transferred the ownership of a vehicle and who has delivered the vehicle to the purchaser or transferee shall not be civilly or criminally liable for the parking, abandonment, or operation of the vehicle by another after the sale. Modifies duties of the Oklahoma Tax Commission and moto license agents; requires training of personnel authorized to perform inspections and examinations; modifies time at which certain fee required to be paid and modifies apportionment thereof; prohibiting suit against certain agencies and persons liable for certain acts; requires the Department of promulgate rules; provides an effective date and declares an emergency.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.
