HB2164 Principal Author(s): Steidley, Dwayne; Williams, Penny; Requires Oklahoma state higher education facilities to annually publish all tuition and fees free of charge to any person requesting any information relating to tuition or fees at that institution.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.04/29/96, Senate Amendments - Rejected, 04/29/96, Conference Requested, 04/30/96, Conferees Named - House, 04/30/96, Conference Granted - Senate, 04/30/96, Conferees Named - Senate, 05/01/96, CCR-CCS Submitted.

HB2172 Principal Author(s): Kirby, Ron M.; Maddox, James R.; Modifies Oklahoma Pawnshop Act. Prohibits issuing a license for a location within a county with a population of less than 11,000 or in counties of more than 11,000 population when there is an active pawnshop license for every 11,000 or fraction thereof of the population.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.04/30/96, Conference Granted - Senate, 04/30/96, Conferees Named - Senate, 05/01/96, CCR-CCS Submitted.

HB2177 Principal Author(s): Erwin, Randall L.; Shurden, Frank; Allows for written notification to the Department of Wildlife Conservation when a person wishes to hold animal pelts for longer than ten (10) days; states that any antlers or horns that are sold or traded shall be removed so as to not leave any portion of the skull attached; provides that such antlers or horns shall also be cut into pieces not longer than 12 inches.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.05/01/96, Governor Action - Signed.

HB2179 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; Thomas, Tommy; Allows the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to accept federal grant money to augment programs within its jurisdiction to reimburse the state for any such assistance payments; allows the authority to make apportionments with said funds.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.04/29/96, CCR Submitted.

HB2182 Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike; Stipe, Gene; States legislative intent to protect the rights of child witnesses; defines terms; states considerations that must be considered before deciding to accept the testimony of a child witness; establishes who can be present during the testimony of a child witness; provides for accompaniment of a child witness during testimony.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.04/30/96, CCR Submitted.

HB2188 Principal Author(s): Greenwood, Joan; Hendrick, Howard H.; Modifies the definition of "medical savings account" to include that which is offered by the State and Education Employees Group

Insurance Board; allows any funds remaining in a medical savings account at the end of a tax year to remain in the account for future medical expenses; provides for payment of account funds to the account holder in the event the employee is no longer employed; also provides for an option to retain the account after employment; also allows for transfer of account to a new employer without penalty; requires the board to offer a high deductible health benefit plan; provides employees participating in a deferred compensation plan the option of transferring those funds to a medical savings account.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.04/30/96, CCR-CCS Submitted.

HB2189 Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Williams, Penny; Requires the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board to pay for medical services and treatment rendered by out-of-state hospitals at the same level paid to an in-state hospital if the insured employee was referred by a physician and it was the closest hospital to the employee's place of residence, unless the board has otherwise contracted with an out-of-state hospital.; Emergency.04/30/96, CCR Submitted.

HB2192 Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed; Modifies language relating to the Oklahoma Youth Apprenticeship Committee.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.05/01/96, CCR Submitted.

HB2193 Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed; Allows school districts to create their own educational improvement plan; deletes required components of said plan; allows districts to request an exemption from any statutory requirement or State Board rule not related to bilingual and special education programs, health and safety provisions, school finance, State Aid, pupil formula weights, teacher salary and teacher retirement, the Oklahoma School Testing Program and the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.05/01/96, CCR Submitted.

HB2198 Principal Author(s): Steidley, Dwayne; Williams, Don; Creates the Property Tax Deferral Act.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.04/29/96, Senate Amendments - Rejected, 04/29/96, Conference Requested, 04/30/96, Referred To Conference Committee, Hb2198 (C), 04/30/96, Conferees Named - House, 04/30/96, Conference Granted - Senate, 04/30/96, Conferees Named - Senate, 05/01/96, CCR Submitted.

HB2202 Principal Author(s): Fisher, Ted V.; McCorkell, Don Jr.; Modifies the definition of "commercial airline" to include unscheduled services. Relates to aircraft excise taxes.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.05/01/96, CCR-CCS Submitted.

HB2208 Principal Author(s): Cotner, Howard; Ferguson, Larry R.; Long, Ed; Maddux, Elmer L.; Creates the Motor Fuel Tax Code.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.04/30/96, CCR Submitted.

HB2214 Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Easley, Kevin A.; Permits acquiring banks to establish unused branch banking rights. Requires agency relationship of bank holding companies, branches, and affili-

ates banks to be consistent with banking practices and regulations.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.05/01/96, CCR Submitted.

HB2231 Principal Author(s): Voskuhl, Sean; Williams, Penny; Creates the Family Centered and Community Designed Services Act; states the most frequently identified problems experienced by families seeking to access services or receiving services for their children; requires certain agencies to implement the system for the delivery of services to children and their families as provided by said act; designates responsibilities for the Oklahoma Planning and Coordinating Council for Services to Children and Youth; modifies qualifications for service on the council; modifies duties of the Joint Legislative Committee for the Review of Coordination of Services to Children and Youth.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.04/30/96, CCR Submitted.

HB2239 Principal Author(s): Bell, Jack; Erwin, Randall L.; Modifies language relating to fishing and game licenses.; Effective Date: 11/01/96.04/29/96, Governor Action - Veto.

HB2243 Principal Author(s): Cozort, Wayne; Fisher, Ted V.; Adds detention centers operated by or through contract with a county to applicable facilities which listed circumstances where the use of physical force related to children housed in said facilities shall be allowed.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.04/29/96, Governor Action - Signed.

HB2250 Principal Author(s): Paulk, William R.; Snyder, Mark; Relates to the Plumbing License Law of 1955; directs the State Board of Health, through the Commissioner of Health, to promulgate rules governing the adoption of standards for plumbing published by a nationally recognized code body for the establishment of a minimum standard of plumbing installation in this state; modifies language, exempting individuals who perform plumbing work on their own residence.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency.04/29/96, CCR-CCS Submitted, 04/29/96, CCR Read - House.
