**SB 587** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Paulk, William R. Includes advanced practice nurses in list of medical practitioners included in definition of prescription; includes advanced practice nurses in definition of licensed practitioner; specifies that advanced registered nurse practitioners, clinical nurse specialists, certified nurse-midwives, certified registered nurse anesthetist, and advanced practice nurses such nurses may not dispense drugs but may dispense professional samples; allows such nurses to diagnose, prescribe, distribute, and administer medicines, devices, or treatments as defined by the Board of Nursing; requires such nurses practitioners to accept responsibility to practice in accepted manner for their profession.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. 04/29/96, House Amendments - Rejected, 04/29/96, Conference Requested, 04/29/96, Conferees Named - Senate, 05/01/96, CCR Submitted, 05/01/96, CCR Read - Senate.
