## Senate Measures Continued

**SB 1111** Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce. Modifies estate tax deduction for the estate of a decedent who dies before Jan. 1, 1997. The exemption shall be \$175,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1997, and before Jan. 1, 1998, the exemption shall be \$250,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1998, and before Jan. 1, 1999, the exemption shall be \$350,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1999 and before Jan. 1, 2000, the exemption shall be \$450,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2000, and before Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$550,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$600,000,000. **SB 1130** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William R. **SB 1150** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam. Lengthens amount of time needed before the arrested is brought before a court from 24 to 48 hours. **SB 1152** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Hefner, Jerry W. Creates the Substance Abuse Prevention Program. Provides guidelines for children in need of supervision or delinquent.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 04/30/96, House Amendments - Rejected, 04/30/96, Conference Requested, 04/30/96, Conference Granted - Senate, 04/30/96, Conferees Named - Senate, 05/01/96, CCR Submitted, 05/01/96, CCR Read - Senate.

**SB 1163** Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Williams, Penny. Changes name of act of "Educational Deregulation Act" to "Oklahoma Trailblazer Schools and School Districts Act." Removes some requirements for eligibility for deregulation, states limits for deregulation, provides limitation of number of districts and school sites that may be deregulated.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. 04/29/96, House Amendments - Rejected, 04/29/96, Conference Requested, 04/30/96, Conferees Named - Senate, 05/01/96, CCR Submitted, 05/01/96, CCR Read - Senate.

**SB 1166** Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Voskuhl, Sean. Requires disclosure of actual payments if copayments are based on discounted or nondiscounted charges; requires explanation of benefits and copayments to clearly and accurately disclose actual amount paid or to be paid.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. 04/29/96, House Amendments - Rejected, 04/29/96, Conference Requested, 04/30/96, Conference Granted - Senate, 04/30/96, Conferees Named - Senate, 05/01/96, CCR Submitted, 05/01/96, CCR Read - Senate.

**SB 1167** Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Steidley, Dwayne. Provides regulations relating to simulcast races and fair associations licensed to conduct race meeting; clarifies days considered racing days. Provides for percentage of winnings to be received from wagering and provides for distribution of such moneys. States Oklahoma does not conduct live racing.; Emergency. 04/30/96, Conferees Changed, 05/01/96, CCR-CCS Submitted, 05/01/96, CCR Read - Senate.

**SB 1175** Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Cain, Bernest. Excludes collection of child support from statute of limitations; provides for liens against property; prevents child support from becoming dormant for any purpose.
