HB1238 Principal Author(s): Crocker, Ed; Easley, Kevin A. Relates to public finance; requires the disclosure of the identity of any public official or spouse that is an owner or operator or who is a principal of any legal entity which owns or operates a project or who has any financial interest, whether direct or indirect, in the project that no conflict of interest exists because of the public official's or any person who was public official during the immediately preceding 24 months; requires that a list of all political campaign contributions made in Oklahoma during the 48 months immediately preceding the submission of the application of all persons that will have a financial interest in the project.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

HB1672 Principal Author(s): Toure, Opio Modifies definitions of terms in the Employment Security Act of 1980; provides conditions under which an employee cannot be disqualified for benefits.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. HB2079 Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Williams, Don Modifies language as it relates to class size limitations; provides calculation formulas; states penalties;

HB2088 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies language relating to the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Plan; states that any person wishing to continue with their life insurance policy after retirement shall pay the full cost of such life insurance at the rate established by the board.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2090 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies language relating to the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and Retirement System.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

HB2094 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies references to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Rejected - Senate, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2101 Principal Author(s): Begley, Jack; Capps, Gilmer N.; Ferguson, Larry R. Allows officers or employees of a municipality with a population of more than 2,500 to conduct business with said municipality; allows members of any board of education of a municipality with a population of over 2,500 to furnish materials or supplies to said municipality; allows members of any board of education within a municipality with a population of more than 2,500 to vote on contracts between area vocational-technical schools and the entity by which the member is employed.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Third CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

HB2143 Principal Author(s): Harrison, J. Berry; Taylor, Gary Modifies sunset date from July 1, 1996, to July 1, 2002, for the Plumbing Examiners, Water and Wastewater Works Advisory Council; recreates the Advisory Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse, and OETA; creates the Advisory Commission on Latin American and Hispanic Affairs; stating legislative intent; provides for appointments and responsibilities; and codification.; Governor Action - Veto

HB2147 Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; McCorkell, Don Jr. Creates the Procurement Procedures Act; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second CCR Submitted To House

HB2202 Principal Author(s): Fisher, Ted V.; McCorkell, Don Jr. Modifies the definition of "commercial airline" to include unscheduled services. Relates to aircraft excise taxes.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To House, Second CCR Read - House

HB2271 Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Douglass, Brooks Increases minimum payments and assessments related to victim compensation.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Third CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

HB2294 Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Shurden, Frank Authorizes Wildlife Conservation to sell advertising in any publication, media production or other informational material it produces.; Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

HB2346 Principal Author(s): Roach, Russ; Williams, Penny Directs the Commissioner of Public Safety to require a gas cap integrity test for motor vehicles.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. Governor Action - Signed

HB2361 Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Weaver, Robert E. Allows investments to be made by banking institution trust departments.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

HB2362 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Morgan, Fred Relates to financial privacy; provides exemptions from notice and challenge procedures; provides for customer non-notification; sets standards for the calculation of reasonable fees.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

HB2393 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Seikel, Mark Creates the Early Identification and Service Support for Children and Families Act; modifies duties of the Joint Legislative Committee for Review of Coordination of Services to Children and Youth. Changes name of Legislative committee and provides for the results of early screening procedures.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Third CCR Rejected - House, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2403 Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies deposits to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund to allocate 25% of each deposit as follows: 3/4 to the AG Evidence Fund and 1/4 to the AG Revolving Fund.; Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

HB2416 Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Allows an equal number of years of employment with the Corporation Commission as a field inspector to qualify an applicant for employment with the Conservation Commission for positions requiring experience in the production of oil and gas.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Third CCR Submitted To House

HB2437 Principal Author(s): Eddins, Joe; Long, Ed Requires that underage students shall participate in developmental assessments to determine if the child is ready for admittance to kindergarten; requires the board of education to develop and adopt a written plan outlining the kindergarten program being offered to the underaged child.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To House, Second CCR Read - House
