**HB2463** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Dunegan, James H. Modifies date to 1997 relating to required FTE recommendations from the Human Resources Management Advisory Committee.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate, Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

**HB2466** Principal Author(s): Hager, James E.; Long, Ed Amends language relating to a teacher's right to due process and compensation or benefits when a board of education receives a superintendent's recommendation for a teacher's dismissal unless the career teacher is convicted of a felony.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted, Second CCR Submitted To House

**HB2483** Principal Author(s): Leist, M. C.; Shurden, Frank Updates language pertaining to the powers of the State Board of Agriculture.; Emergency. Governor Action - Veto

**HB2512** Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Wright, Gerald "Ged" Transfers authority over the Oklahoma Office of Volunteerism from the Office of the Secretary of State to the Department of Civil Emergency Management; Creates the Oklahoma Commission on Volunteerism; directs the Office of the Secretary of State to provide staff support; states powers and duties.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

**HB2541** Principal Author(s): Smith, Jerry L.; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies requirements of nonlawyer judges as they relate to the filing of traffic violation reports with the Department of Public Safety; reduces number of hours of continuing legal education required from twelve (12) hours to six (6) hours; includes attendance of at least one (1) day of a state judicial conference from a judge; provides for verification of said attendance.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Governor Action - Signed

**HB2553** Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Seikel, Mark Relates to the Agents Licensing Act; deletes surplus line insurance brokers from licensing requirements; adds fraternal agents to licensing requirements; modifies language and fees; modifies educational requirements.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

**HB2648** Principal Author(s): Mitchell, Bill J.; Monson, Angela Requires the Oklahoma Department of Health to establish and enforce standards and requirements for the Home Health Care Act; adding to coverage of rules and requiring certain disclosure. Requires application fee, with certain information from persons; requiring certain investigation and determi-

nation; provides for expiration of licensure; denial of licensure; revocation or suspension of license; specifying grounds and issuances of renewals; authorizes certain relief; making certain person civilly liable for certain damages; authorizes civil relief regardless of criminal prosecution; provides for other remedies; codification and effective date.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2692** Principal Author(s): Benson, Loyd L.; Fisher, Ted V. Places the Juvenile Justice Advisory and Oversight Committee under the supervision of the Office of Juvenile Affairs; states that the amount of a juvenile's earnings designated for restitution to victims shall be placed in the Juvenile Restitution Revolving Fund; states that acquisitions or purchases of clothing for juveniles or acquisitions of food for group homes under the custody of the Office of Juvenile Affairs shall be exempt from the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act; expands provisional scope to include purchases from such funds received by offices administered by the Office of Juvenile Affairs.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

**HB2698** Principal Author(s): Ervin, Mike; Henry, Brad Allows the Department of Human Services to charge a service fee to those obliged to pay child support to cover administrative costs; states that such fees shall be deposited into the Child Support Revenue Enhancement Fund.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

**HB2704** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Modifies language relating to the Oklahoma Municipal Code.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

**HB2755** Principal Author(s): Brown, Ben; Coleman, Carolyn Requires the Department of Juvenile Justice to provide a uniform system of assessment of the reading ability of each juvenile upon initial placement in an institution or facility.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Governor Action - Signed

**HB2812** Principal Author(s): Beutler, Randy; Hendrick, Howard H. Clarifies language pertaining to the issuance of and qualification for a restricted commercial vehicle driver's license to persons under seventeen years of age for custom harvest purposes.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**HB2874** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Modifies definitions to include natural gas; increases the membership of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board from eighteen (18) to thirtyone (31); decreases membership of said board to twenty-seven (27) after Jul. 1, 1996 and provides for reapportionment of members; modifies the assessment to be levied for board funding from two cents per barrel (\$0.02) to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the gross revenues received at the wellhead for oil, natural gas,

casinghead gas or condensate; increases amount retained by the board from One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000); Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted, Third CCR Submitted To House

**HB2953** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Seikel, Mark Clarifies legislative intent regarding reporting obligations within the Oklahoma Child Abuse Reporting and Prevention Act.; Effective Date: 11/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To House

**HB2960** Principal Author(s): Seikel, Mark; Weedn, Trish Directs DHS to cooperate with and help promote foster parent associations in each county; provide additional services relating to the placement of children in foster care; develop a policy of accident, personal liability, and automobile liability insurance; and develop a procedure to determine the ability of parents to pay part or all of the costs for foster care.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate

**HB2964** Principal Author(s): Cain, Bernest; Seikel, Mark Changes the name of the Developmentally or Physically Disabled Persons Community Residential Living Act to the Community Residential Living for Persons with Developmental Disabilities Act; transfers jurisdiction to the Department of Human Services; states that any related rules promulgated by the State Board of Health shall remain in effect until such rules are superseded by rules from the Commission for Human Services; provides for prior licensure of group homes.; Emergency. Third CCR Read - House, Called Up For Consideration, Third CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Third CCR Submitted To Senate, Third CCR Read - Senate, Called Up For Consideration, Third CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

**HB2969** Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Seikel, Mark Directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to amend the state Medicaid plan to provide a funding source for payment of temporary managers or state monitors in facilities certified to provide long-term care services and community-based service provider facility under Medicaid.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Read - House, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Bill Passed - House, Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate

**HB2975** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ Prohibits requirement for filing paternity affidavits when consent for adoption has been given.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Second CCR Adopted - House, Fourth Reading - House, Bill And Emergency Passed - House, Signed & Transmitted To Senate, Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate
