**SB 1061** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Wilkerson, Dick States that any order directing a defendant to pay costs of representation shall be a lien against all real and personal property of the defendant and may be filed against such property as provided by law for such liens.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

**SB 1071** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Long, Ed Lists student suspension options for students guilty of immorality or violation of school regulations; states that the suspended pupil may not be returned to the teacher's classroom without the teacher's consent or unless a district appeals committee determines that such placement is appropriate.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

**SB 1077** Principal Author(s): Long, Ed; Wells, Dale W. Modifies statutory sections pertaining to itemization of expenditures, responsibilities of Department of Central Services, and boards of education.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**SB 1106** Principal Author(s): Herbert, Dave; Roberts, Larry D. Modifies sections pertaining to the Oklahoma State and Education Employee Group Insurance Board and the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council; requiring legislative approval; providing for exclusivity of responsibilities; allowing state legislators to opt out of state insurance coverage. Provides an effective date with emergency.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

**SB 1111** Principal Author(s): Pope, Clay; Price, Bruce Modifies estate tax deduction for the estate of a decedent who dies before Jan. 1, 1997. The exemption shall be \$175,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1997, and before Jan. 1, 1998, the exemption shall be \$250,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1998, and before Jan. 1, 1999, the exemption shall be \$350,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 1999 and before Jan. 1, 2000, the exemption shall be \$450,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2000, and before Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$550,000,000. For the estate of a decedent who dies on or after Jan. 1, 2001, the exemption shall be \$600,000,000. The amount of the exemption allowed is pursuant to the provisions of Section 809 of this title.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**SB 1115** Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies statutory references relating to drivers licenses, motorcycle safety instruction permits, and special motorcycle permits.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Governor Action - Signed

**SB 1122** Principal Author(s): Bastin, Gary; Brown, Ben Authorizes municipalities to prosecute minors for violating firearms ordinances.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**SB 1130** Principal Author(s): Dickerson, Larry; Paulk, William R. States that state employee payroll deductions shall be made for membership dues or contributions to a foundation in the Oklahoma Public Employees Association or any other statewide association limited to state employee membership with a minimum membership of 1,000 dues-paying members.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**SB 1163** Principal Author(s): McCorkell, Don Jr.; Williams, Penny Changes name of act of "Educational Deregulation Act" to "Oklahoma Trailblazer Schools and School Districts Act." Modifies limitations for deregulation and provides for effective date and an emergency.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**SB 1192** Principal Author(s): Adair, Larry E.; Herbert, Dave Creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Act; creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Advisory Committee within the Department of Transportation; creates the Oklahoma Tourism and Passenger Rail Revolving Fund.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Governor Action - Signed

**SB 1209** Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam Modifies references relating to vehicle inspection fees.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Fourth CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Transmitted To House, Fourth CCR Submitted To House, Fourth CCR Read - House

**SB 1215** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Hutchison, Joe J. States that no person shall operate any vessel on any waters in the state while under the influence of any substance listed in the Uniformed Controlled Substances Act or any combination of alcohol and said substance; authorizes the Grand River Dam Authority to set maximum lake speed limits; states that no person shall operate any vessel on any waters of the state, except those that are privately owned, at speeds in excess of those established.; Emergency. Third CCR Submitted To Senate, Third CCR Read - Senate

**SB 1225** Principal Author(s): Easley, Kevin A.; Rice, Larry Adds definitions relating to environment and natural resources; expands jurisdiction of the Conservation Commission to include recipients of nonpoint pollution funds; states availability of the related revolving funds.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

**SB 1227** Principal Author(s): Robinson, Ben H.; Stanley, Fred Relating to state government; allowing certain entities to participate in the State and Education Employees Group Health and Life Insurance plans under certain circumstances; modifies group of retirees allowed to participate in the dental insurance plan; and provides for an effective date; declares an emergency.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, Fourth CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Fourth CCR Submitted To House, Fourth CCR Read - House

**SB 1230** Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura W.; Brown, Ben Makes it unlawful for a person under the age of twenty-one (21) to operate a vehicle who has a blood alcohol concentration of 0.02 percent.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

**SB 1310** Principal Author(s): Shedrick, Bernice; Steidley, Dwayne Modifies statutory references relating to workers' compensation.; Effective Date: 11/01/96 Emergency. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted, Second CCR Submitted To Senate, Second CCR Read - Senate, Called Up For Consideration, Motion To Adopt CCR, Second CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Motion To Reconsider - Senate, Motion To Reconsider Withdrawn, Signed & Transmitted To House, Second CCR Submitted To House

**SB 1320** Principal Author(s): Settle, Bill; Smith, Jerry L. Clarifies statutory references, merges duplicate sections of earlier passed legislation.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. House Introduction And First Reading

**SCR 57** Principal Author(s): Kinnamon, Don; Robinson, Ben H.; Sadler, Al A Concurrent Resolution relating to atomic veterans.; Called Up For Consideration, Adopted - House

**SCR 70** Principal Author(s): Glover, Jim R.; Helton, Sam; Kirby, Ron M. Memorializes the U.S. Congress to provide certain compensation for disabled veterans.; Referred Direct To Calendar, Adopted - Senate

**SCR 71** Principal Author(s): Anthony, Calvin J.; Monson, Angela Creates the Legislative Task Force on Parity for Mental Illness Insurance Coverage.; Referred Direct To Calendar, Adopted - Senate
