HB1185 Principal Author(s): Long, Lewis Jr.; Thornbrugh, C. Michael Authorizes any sheriff's office or campus police agency to dispose of by public sale, destruction, donation, or transfer for use to a governmental subdivision personal property which has come into its possession; provides procedure for the same; establishes special funds to hold proceeds of the sale of such property and authorizes expenditures from said fund.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

HB1238 Principal Author(s): Crocker, Ed; Easley, Kevin A. Relates to public finance; requires the disclosure of the identity of any public official or spouse that is an owner or operator or who is a principal of any legal entity which owns or operates a project or who has any financial interest, whether direct or indirect, in the project that no conflict of interest exists because of the public official's or any person who was public official during the immediately preceding 24 months; requires that a list of all political campaign contributions made in Oklahoma during the 48 months immediately preceding the submission of the application of all persons that will have a financial interest in the project.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. HB1621 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Williams, Penny Modifies language relating to the Ad Valorem Tax Code; provides an exemption for households earning less than \$12,000.; Effective Date: 01/01/97. CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted, Second CCR Submitted To House

HB2053 Principal Author(s): Blackburn, Debbie; Boyd, Laura W.; Brown, Ben; Cox, Kevin; Sadler, Al; Voskuhl, Sean; Weaver, Robert E. Modifies requirements for those involved in child abuse and neglect situations; requires criminal history investigations of foster parent applicants; provides for prompt medical treatment for abused children; provides for a special review application to be made after removing a child from custody; states that no child shall be placed in the custody of any individual subject to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act; provides for legal representation for abused children; transfers responsibility of removed children with the Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs; provides for review and approval of training curricula; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Signed & Transmitted To Governor

HB2059 Principal Author(s): Boyd, Laura W.; Long, Ed Creates the Oklahoma Tuition Savings Account Act; provides aid and assistance in financing for postsecondary education; defines terms; allows residents to contribute to a tuition savings account not to exceed \$5,000; allows for adjustments in the Oklahoma taxable income and the Oklahoma adjusted gross in-

come; provides for tax exemptions for contributions made after December 31, 1996.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Second CCR Rejected - House, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2065 Principal Author(s): Cox, Kevin; Hobson, Cal Creates the Oklahoma Athletic Trainers Act; modifies definition.; Effective Date: 07/01/96 Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

HB2143 Principal Author(s): Harrison, J. Berry; Taylor, Gary Modifies sunset date from July 1, 1996, to July 1, 2002, for the Plumbing Examiners, Water and Wastewater Works Advisory Council, Special Agency Account Board, Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters, EMS Advisory Council, Committee for Day Treatment Standards, Basic Health Benefits Board, Advisory Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse, and OETA.; CCR Rejected, Further Conference Requested, Further Conference Granted

HB2179 Principal Author(s): Hendrick, Howard H.; Thomas, Tommy Allows the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to accept federal grant money to augment programs within its jurisdiction to reimburse the state for any such assistance payments; allows the authority to make apportionments with said funds.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Governor Action - Signed

HB2182 Principal Author(s): Mass, Mike; Stipe, Gene States legislative intent to protect the rights of child witnesses; defines terms; states considerations that must be considered before deciding to accept the testimony of a child witness; establishes who can be present during the testimony of a child witness; provides for accompaniment of a child witness during testimony.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

HB2271 Principal Author(s): Bryant, John; Douglass, Brooks Increases minimum payments and assessments related to victim compensation.; Emergency. Second CCR Submitted To House

HB2362 Principal Author(s): Henry, Brad; Morgan, Fred Relates to financial privacy; provides exemptions from notice and challenge procedures; provides for customer non-notification; sets standards for the calculation of reasonable fees.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. HB2379 Principal Author(s): Askins, Jari; Hendrick, Howard H. States that restricted driver's licenses shall become nonrenewable; provides conditions upon

which restricted status may be removed.; Emergency. Called Up For Consideration, CCR Adopted - Senate, Fourth Reading - Senate, Bill And Emergency Passed - Senate, Signed & Returned To House, Enrolled - House

HB2393 Principal Author(s): Monson, Angela; Seikel, Mark Creates the Early Identification and Service Support for Children and Families Act; modifies duties of the Joint Legislative Committee for Review of Coordination of Services to Children and Youth. Changes name of Legislative committee and provides for the results of early screening procedures.; Effective Date: 11/01/96. Second CCR Submitted To House
