

# Bills Effective Nov. 1, 1996

**HB1088** Provides for the deduction from OK adjusted gross income any medical expenses incurred in the process of adoption of a minor. Principal Authors: Henry, Brad; Roach, Russ; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED: Date:05/23/96

**HB1185** Authorizes any sheriff's office or campus police agency to dispose of by public sale, destruction, donation, or transfer for use to a governmental subdivision personal property which has come into its possession; provides procedure for the same; establishes special funds to hold proceeds of the sale of such property and authorizes expenditures from said fund. **HB1880** Clarifies language relating to the dental profession. Creates and sets qualifications for a Board of Dentistry which is granted powers to enforce regulations and set standards of professional responsibility over the dental profession. **HB1989** Allows public trusts to purchase material and equipment from state contracts through central services. Originally modified duties of the district court judge in issuing certain instructions relating to acquisition of lands by purchase, donation or condemnation. **HB2053** Modifies requirements for those involved in child abuse and neglect situations; requires criminal history investigations of foster parent applicants; provides for prompt medical treatment for abused children; provides for a special review application to be made after removing a child from custody; states that no child shall be placed in the custody of any individual subject to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act; provides for legal representation for abused children; transfers responsibility of removed children with the Oklahoma Office

**HB2087** Modifies references to the Oklahoma State Pension Commission. Principal Authors: Monson, Angela; Roberts, Larry D. Status: GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/08/96

**HB2089** Relates to the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System. Modifies the definition of fixed base salary to include, longevity, educational allowances, and normal compensation paid on a regularly scheduled pay period of which said pay period shall include holidays, annual leave and sick leave. **HB2100** Allows for retired members of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, Capitol Patrol or Lake Patrol to purchase the sidearm and shotgun or rifle issued to them; allows for the cost of the weapon to be obtained by the State Purchasing Director. Principal Authors: Rice, Larry; Wilkerson, Dick; Status: GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/16/96

**HB2101** Allows officers or employees of a municipality with a population of less than 2,500 to conduct business with said municipality; allows members of any board of edu-

cation of a municipality with a population of less than 2,500 to furnish materials or supplies to said municipality; allows members of any board of education within a municipality with a population of less than 2,500 to vote on contracts between area vocational-technical schools and the entity by which the member is employed. **HB2112** Modifies penalty for defacing, stealing or possessing road signs or markers and provides effective date. Principal Authors: Hilliard, Danny; Weedn, Trish; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/15/96

**HB2115** Modifies condition by which murder in the first degree occurs in certain circumstances. Principal Authors: Breckinridge, Flint; Smith, Jerry L.; Status: GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/14/96

**HB2120** Changes the name of military security guards to police officers. Principal Authors: Wells, Dale W. Wright, Gerald "Ged"; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/03/96

**HB2122** Provides certain requirements of attorneys, modifying procedures related to issuance of subpoenas; discovery procedures with respect to expert witnesses; and motions for protective orders. Authorizes methods for taking depositions and provisions related to examinations of witnesses; imposing requirement related to objections to evidence. Provides safekeeping of depositions and requiring copies be recorded in a certain manner, modifying reference; providing for presentation of depositions during evidentiary proceeding and with respect to interrogations. **HB2124** Provides instructions relating to the sale or transfer of ownership of vehicles, requiring certain notice to Oklahoma Tax Commission and gives time limit and information required. Principal Authors: Fisher,
