

Bills Effective Nov. 1, 1996

HB2622 Provides criminal penalty for any person falsely executing a written declaration as a witness or misrepresenting his or her identity with the intent to defraud, relevant to the execution of self-proved wills and codicils. HB2623 States that a group or combination of persons or risks shall not be considered a "fictitious" group upon meeting the conditions provided within this section. Principal Authors: Cox, Kevin; Hendrick, Howard H.; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/09/96

HB2637 Changes the name of the "OK Nongame Improvement Program" to the "Wildlife Diversity Program". Creates a revolving fund in the State Treasury for the purpose of receiving individual donations via income tax returns for the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission. HB2648 Requires the Oklahoma Department of Health to establish and enforce standards and requirements for the Home Health Care Act; adding to coverage of rules and requiring certain disclosure. Requires application fee, with certain information from persons; requiring certain investigation and determination; provides for expiration of licensure; denial of licensure; revocation or suspension of license; specifying grounds and issuances of renewals; authorizes certain relief; making certain person civilly liable for certain damages; authorizes civil relief regardless of criminal prosecution; provides for other remedies; codification and effective date. HB2701 States that all locomotives shall be equipped with a bell or whistle, provides for sounding distance from crossing and lists penalties for neglect. Principal Authors: Herbert, Dave; Satterfield, Shelby; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/23/96

HB2726 Authorizes local school districts and county or city-county health departments may enter into agreements related to assuring that a child who is returning to school after an absence due to head lice infection is no longer afflicted. HB2745 Directs the Department of Transportation County Advisory Board to establish a maximum purchase allocation for participating counties and to establish an interest rate which may be charged on all leases or lease-purchase agreements. HB2755 Requires the Department of Juvenile Justice to provide a uniform system of assessment of the reading ability of each juvenile upon initial placement in an institution or facility. Principal Authors: Brown, Ben; Coleman, Carolyn; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/28/96

HB2796 Provides that recordable instruments shall be written and printed in English and presented in a certain manner. Principal Authors: Askins, Jari; Smith, Jerry L.; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/20/96

HB2893 Creates the Oklahoma Limited Liability Partnership Act. Principal Authors: Fisher, Ted V.; Settle, Bill; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/23/96

HB2901 Allows counties reimbursement for volunteer training expenses. Allows a county sheriff to charge \$5.00 per card for fingerprinting individuals. Allows sheriff to deduct money from the Inmate Trust Fund Checking Account to cover medical co-payment's for medical services rendered while incarcerated and for copies requested by an inmate from the Inmate Trust Fund Checking Account. HB2934 Modifies definitions relating to the Health Care Freedom of Choice Act. Requires certain policies be brought into compliance and clarifies compliance. Principal Authors: Glover, Jim R.; Stipe, Gene; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/12/96

HB2950 Modifies language pertaining to private prison facilities. Principal Authors: Brown, Ben; Fields, Lloyd; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/08/96

HB2960 Directs DHS to cooperate with and help promote foster parent associations in each county; provide additional services relating to the placement of children in foster care; develop a policy of accident, personal liability, and automobile liability insurance; and develop a procedure to determine the ability of parents to pay part or all of the costs for foster care.
