

Bills Effective Nov. 1, 1996

SB 740 Requires the State Dept. of Education to recognize for purposes of certification and salary increments teachers certified in Oklahoma employed by DHS Child Study Center at University Hospital. Principal Authors: Case, Bill; Herbert, Dave; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/17/96

SB 745 Requires licensure of out-of-state physicians who regularly provide diagnostic evaluations to in-state physicians or patients through electronic communications. Principal Authors: Anthony, Calvin J.; Williams, Don; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/07/96

SB 765 Authorizes Department of Transportation to purchase individual safety recognition awards for its employees. Principal Authors: Kirby, Ron M.; Weedn, Trish; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/07/96

SB 786 Authorizes Oklahoma Real Estate Commission to prescribe fees by rule. Removes the power of the Commission to have jurisdiction over persons who are no longer licensed. Requires persons who have active management control over persons required to be licensed to also possess a license as a real estate broker. SB 797 Allows school districts to prohibit dogs from running at large within one thousand (500) feet of specified property. Principal Authors: Fisher, Ted V.; Tyler, Michael; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/18/96

SB 879 Recreates the State Board of Certified Shorthand Reporters. Principal Authors: Harrison, J. Berry; Taylor, Gary; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/08/96

SB 881 Recreates the Oklahoma Education Television Authority. Principal Authors: Harrison, J. Berry; Taylor, Gary; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/08/96

SB 886 Provides for special license plates for police officers. Principal Authors: Askins, Jari; Helton, Sam; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/07/96

SB 932 Relates to the Oklahoma Nursing Home Care Act; clarifies the definition of "administrator;" states that if the administrator's facility has less than 16 beds, they may be in charge of more than one facility, providing it is within not more than a 15 mile radius and the total number of facilities does not exceed 6 and the total number of beds does not exceed 64. SB 947 Modifies procedures and provides for administrative fines and penalties for violations of the Alarm Industry Act. Principal Authors: Leftwich, Keith; Paulk, William R.; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:06/13/96

SB 977 Requires DHS to take into consideration rate increases necessary for the adequate treatment of developmentally disabled clients when setting reimbursement rates. Principal Authors: Fisher, Ted V.; Tyler, Michael; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/01/96

SB 995 Restricts the power of certain boards to bring a declaratory ruling against any person or entity other than the licensees of that board or persons holding themselves out as licensees of that board. Principal Authors: Steidley, Dwayne; Williams, Don; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:03/14/96

SB 999 Authorizes for cities, towns and counties to jointly create a hospital authority; allows said authority to levy a two percent (2%) tax on the gross proceeds or gross receipts derived from all sales or services in the cities, towns or counties that comprise the authority. SB1031 Broadens the authority of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission to levy specified administrative fines against used car dealers; defines consignment sale; redefines used car salesman. Principal Authors: Rozell, Herb; Sadler, Al; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:06/13/96

SB1036 Modifies language and statutory references relating to the Court of Appeals; changes the name of the Court of Appeals to the Court of Civil Appeals. Principal Authors: Johnson, Glen D.; Taylor, Stratton; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/17/96

SB1053 Deletes all confidentiality and sealing requirements relating to juvenile records. Principal Authors: Herbert, Dave; Seikel, Mark; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/21/96

SB1062 Allows for the establishment of a crimes information unit within the Oklahoma Bureau of Investigation. Principal Authors: Rice, Larry; Wilkerson, Dick; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/07/96

SB1097 Modifies and defines language pertaining to Group Homes for Persons with Development Disabilities. Creates interdisciplinary team to determine on-site staffing requirements. Provides that copies of procedures for receipts and investigations be distributed to all providers of group home services. Recodifies language in bill.
