SB1122 Authorizes municipalities to prosecute minors for violating firearms ordinances. Principal Authors: Bastin, Gary; Brown, Ben; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:06/10/96

SB1147 Prohibits the use of accident reports for commercial purposes. Principal Authors: Benson, Loyd L.; Shedrick, Bernice; Status: GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/23/96

SB1166 Requires disclosure of actual payments if copayments are based on discounted or nondiscounted charges; requires explanation of benefits and copayments to clearly and accurately disclose actual amount paid or to be paid. SB1175 Excludes collection of child support from statute of limitations; provides for liens against property; prevents child support from becoming dormant for any purpose. SB1185 Allows for destruction or donation of certain court records that have been microfilmed. Principal Authors: Hastings, Chris; Smith, Jerry L.; Status:GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:05/16/96

SB1224 Requires all sales of aluminum or aluminum alloy be reported, except for the sale of aluminum cans. Principal Authors: Langmacher, Ron; Price, Bruce; Status: GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:04/15/96

SB1230 Makes it unlawful for a person under the age of twenty-one (21) to operate a vehicle who has a blood alcohol concentration of 0.02 percent. Principal Authors: Boyd, Laura W.; Brown, Ben; Status: GOVERNOR ACTION - SIGNED Date:06/11/96

SB1261 Civil procedure. Requiring certain form of pleading for certain transferred action; providing for service by mail to garnishee; providing for service of summons' providing for notice for termination of lease agreement.
