<b>Screening Blood Tests for Early Detection of Cardiovascular (Heart) Disease</b>	All Medicare beneficiaries	100%	0%	0%
<b>Pap Test and Pelvic Exam:</b> Once every 24 months; includes a clinical breast exam  Once every 12 months if high risk/abnormal Pap test in preceding 36 months	All female Medicare beneficiaries	Pap Test, 100% No Part B deductible  For all other exams, 80% No Part B deductible	0% No Part B deductible  For all other exams, 20%	0%
<b>Diabetes Screening Test</b>	All Medicare beneficiaries at risk for diabetes	100%	0%	0%
<b>Diabetes Self-Management Training</b>	All Medicare beneficiaries with diabetes	80% after the Part B deductible	20% after the Part B deductible	0%
<b>Diabetes Monitoring:</b> Includes coverage for glucose monitors, test strips, and lancets	All Medicare beneficiaries with diabetes - must be requested by your doctor	80% after the Part B deductible	20% after the Part B deductible	0%
<b>Bone Mass Measurements:</b> Once every 24 months for qualified individuals	All Medicare beneficiaries at risk for losing bone mass	80% after the Part B deductible	20% after the Part B deductible	0%
