

WHAT TYPE OF ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE?

Out of pocket expenses allowable under this program are:

- ♦ Medical and dental care;
- ♦ Prescriptions;
- ♦ Counseling and rehabilitation;
- ♦ Work loss or loss of support;
- ♦ Caregiver work loss;
- ♦ Crime scene clean-up;
- ♦ Funeral and burial expense.

SOME EXTRA INFO ...

- ♦ Property loss and pain and suffering are not covered.
- ♦ No attorney is needed to file a claim.
- ♦ No arrest or conviction is required.
- ♦ The maximum award is \$20,000. Claims with work loss can be awarded up to \$40,000.
