Find a career path -

Using the assessments provided in OKCIS can encourage exploration, deepen self-knowledge and facilitate choosing a career and postsecondary options.

OKCIS Assessments -

Career Cluster inventory - Identifies career clusters related to users' interests.

Career Quest - Learn about the labor market and generate a list of occupations matching interests, abilities and preferences.

SKILLS - Tie skill preferences to occupations and career paths.

O*NET Interest Profiler - Identify work-related interests to locate possible occupational goals.

O*NET Work Importance Locator - Identify work values and associate them with occupational characteristics.

Reality Check - Select lifestyle options to discover how much users need to earn to support lifestyle choices. Users can also find occupations matching their lifestyle needs or create lifestyles based upon occupation choices.

Sort choices -

This exploratory tool can be used more than once to create lists based on different criteria. It allows users to sort financial aid and postsecondary institutions based on personal characteristics, preferences and goals.

OKCIS is an online system of career development information and activities that sets students and adults on the road to planning.

Administrators, counselors, educators, teachers, students, adults and parents have current, complete and comprehensive resources essential for career development. OKCIS has a Junior option,

which is written on a fifth-grade level, making it ideal for elementary and middle grades, special populations, and environments in which refresher or inception career exploration is key. The OKCIS standard version is written on an eighth-grade level and offers an array of career planning and job placement information.
