summer program overview

The McCarty Center's summer program is designed to provide your child with a comprehensive evaluation and intensive therapy treatment lasting up to 30-days. The length of stay is determined by your child's specific needs as assessed by the treatment team.

Your child may come home on weekends, however; your child is cared for by a registered nurse and direct care specialists 24-hours a day.

There are recreational activities and field trips planned throughout the summer.

Depending on your child's particular needs, they will receive physical therapy, occupational therapy and/or speech and language therapy. Psychological, nutritional and social services counseling are also available.

We can provide your child with orthopedic, dental, vision and almost any other medical specialty consultation they might need.

When your child isn't in therapy or special education classes there will be plenty of recreational activities to enjoy as well as time to just "hang out" with their new summer program friends.

Therapy is conducted in the McCarty Center's expansive therapy area, in the wide and lengthy hallways of the main building, in the aquatherapy pool and the sidewalks and cart paths around the hospital's campus.

Special education classes are held in the multipurpose building on our campus. This facility consists of three classrooms, a game room, a multipurpose room, a library, music room, crafts center and television lounge. Special education classes are taught by an experienced special education teacher.

Recreational activities during the summer program include arts and crafts, trips to the Oklahoma City Zoo, Oklahoma Red Hawks baseball games, fishing, the movies, the mall, Andy Alligator's Water Park and to restaurants. These trips are not only fun, but they are therapeutic. The trips allow your child to put into use what they are learning in their therapy sessions.
