

## **Outreach Services**

An Outreach Consultant is available to provide direct consultation at your school.

Technical assistance offered includes:

- ♦ A Deaf Education certified member to serve as a member of the IEP team.
- ♦ Preservice and in-service programs for public schools which address the needs of students who are deaf or hard of hearing.
- ♦ Classroom Accessibility considerations for students who are deaf or hard of hearing such as classroom modifications, appropriate technological support and acoustical and visual modifications.
- ♦ Assistance with locating interpreters within the State as well as information related to appropriate communication accessibility.

## **On Campus Services**

Provided at no cost through the Student Assessment Center:

- Audiological testing
- Speech/Language Evaluation
- Psychological/Educational Evaluation
- Distribution of free and/ or loaned materials and resources for the deaf

The Oklahoma School for the Deaf is a comprehensive total communication program serving deaf youth birth through 21 throughout the state.

In 2000, OSD was legislatively designated as a statewide resource center for the needs of deaf children and school districts across the state.

Senate Bill #850

In 2012, Senate Bill #1119 was passed which requires Oklahoma School districts to provide parent/guardians of deaf or hard of hearing children with information about the Oklahoma School for the Deaf
