

Voluntary Registry, you may have access to your relative's name, address and other identifying information if all agree. You can make contact at your own discretion.



## **What if I don't want to be found?**

The registry is totally voluntary and you may withdraw your willingness to be reunited with birth family members at any point. OKDHS will protect your privacy if you choose not to have contact with birth family members.

## **Will OKDHS help me with a reunion?**

OKDHS can act as a third party intermediary if you are not comfortable with arranging the reunion yourself. You also need to specify in your notarized registry affidavit whether or not we can release your name, address or phone number, and to which relatives.

## **Who may register?**

Any person 18 years or older who was adopted in Oklahoma and their birth relatives. Also, any person 18 years or older who was separated by Termination of Parental Rights proceedings in Oklahoma and their birth family members.
