

Will OKDHS help me search for my relatives?

Yes. OKDHS has a Confidential Intermediary Search program that provides search services for eligible persons to locate their birth relatives. There is a \$400 fee for the first search and a \$200 fee for each additional search. You must be registered on the Mutual Consent Voluntary Registry for six months before requesting a search. The person who is the subject of the search must sign an agreement that they wish to be found. If they do not wish to be found, their identity will not be disclosed. There is no refund for the search fee, regardless of the outcome of the search.

How do I get on the Registry?

Complete the Oklahoma Mutual Consent Voluntary Registry form. It must be notarized before you mail it. You must submit one of the following as proof of your identity:

- a photo copy of your current driver's license
- a photo copy of your social security card, or
- a photo copy of your birth certificate.

If you move, it is essential that you notify us of your new address and phone number so we can notify you if a relative contacts OKDHS.
