

SUMMARY

This modification will significantly improve the education program by separating the continuing education classes into undergrad and grad level courses. Extension Educators and Specialists can focus their training efforts on teaching core curricula to undergrads while not repeating the same core curricula to grads. Graduates will then be updated with new regulatory and waste management based curricula. The implementation of a grad program will also help to divide audience size, providing a more conducive learning environment. Furthermore, modifying the continuing education to 2 hours will assist with maintaining audience attention.
