

section, the proclamation shall be republished in accordance with paragraph A within twenty-four (24) hours of the first notice.

SECTION 5. A duly proclaimed emergency shall continue and the terms of the proclamation shall be in force for thirty (30) days or until such time as the (mayor/city manager) or the (council/board/commission) shall cause to be published a proclamation that the emergency has ended, whichever is shorter, unless the (council/board/commission) by resolution approved by a majority of all its members extends the proclamation.

SECTION 6. Any person feeling aggrieved by a proclamation of the (mayor/city manager) shall have the right to present the matter to the next regular or special meeting of the (council/board/commission) or to any emergency session called to discuss the water emergency. The (council/board/commission) may exempt such aggrieved person, wholly or in part, from compliance with the proclamation order upon a showing that compliance creates an immediate threat to the person's health or safety. The ruling of the (council/board/commission) by a majority vote of all its members shall be final and binding as to the continuance of any terms of the proclamation. Until and unless the action of the (mayor/city manager) is modified or revoked by action of the (council/board/commission) all water users shall be bound by the proclamation.

SECTION 7. Any person who in any manner directly or indirectly violates or permits others under his supervision, custody or control to violate any term of a duly publish proclamation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Each separate day of water use in violation of such proclamation shall constitute a separate offense and each separate prohibited use on the same day shall constitute a separate offense. Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of _____ dollars (\$ _____) for each offense.

SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
