OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE CONSERVATION

The Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation oversees a large number of wildlife management areas in Oklahoma. Some of these tracts also overlap with Corps of Engineers and Bureau of Reclamation lakes. Because of the large number of areas managed, it is difficult to identify contact individuals for each management area. Instead, a list of game wardens by county has been compiled. Game wardens are empowered as law enforcement agents and may be called on in cases of site vandalism on wildlife lands or other state lands. The following lists include the various wildlife management areas and county game wardens.
